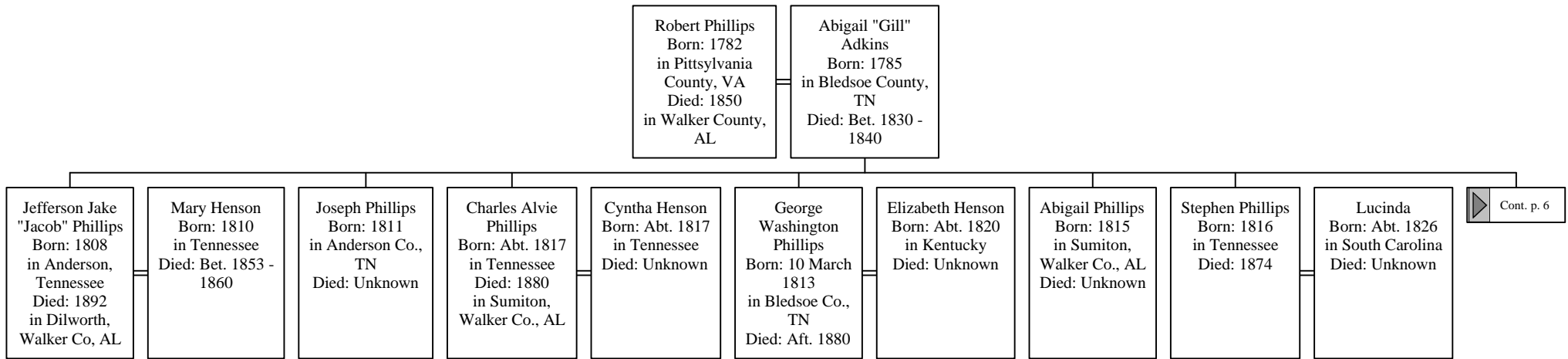

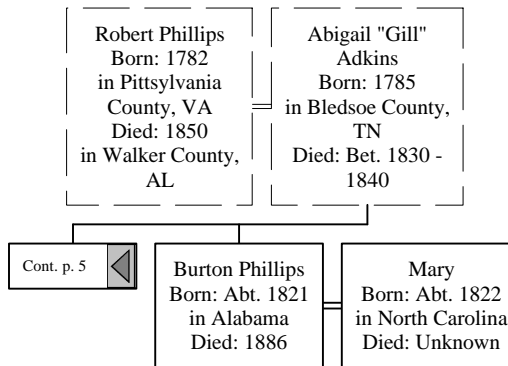

1. ROBERT⁵ PHILLIPS (*TOBIAS*⁴, *GEORGE*³, *TOBIAS*², *JOHN*¹)¹ was born 1782 in Pittsylvania County, VA¹, and died 1850 in Walker County, AL¹. He married ABIGAIL ADKINS¹ 1804¹. She was born 1785 in Bledsoe County, TN¹, and died Bet. 1830 - 1840.

Notes for ROBERT PHILLIPS:

Robert probably migrated from Tennessee to Alabama between 1816 and 1820. Son Stephen, born about 1816, reported his birthplace as Tennessee, and son Burton, born abt 1821, reported his birthplace as Alabama.

In the 1830 Census, Robert Phillips is living in Walker County, Alabama. Living in the house are 1 male between 5 & 10 (Burton), 1 male between 10 & 15 (Stephen), 2 males between 15 & 20 (Joseph & Charles), 1 male age 40 - 50 (Robert age 48), 1 female between 10 & 15 (dau Abigail), and one female age 40 - 50 (wife Abigail). Robert does not own any slaves. Living next door is son Jacob (Jefferson Jake Phillips) and his family.

Robert's wife Abigail apparently died between the 1830 and 1840 Censuses.

In the 1840 Census, Robert is living in Walker County. Living in the house are 1 male age 15-20 (Stephen), 1 male age 20-30 (Burton), and 1 male age 40-50 (Robert). Robert does not own any slaves. Sons Jefferson and G.W. Phillips are living next door.

In the 1850 Census (enumeration date Nov 16), Robert Phillips is living alone in Walker County. He is 69 years old, and was born in Virginia. He is a farmer and lists the value of his real estate as \$500. On the other hand, there is another Robert Phillips, age 61, born in Virginia, living with George W Phillips (enumeration date Dec 21). Perhaps Robert moved and was counted twice.

According to Katherine Southard, Robert and his son Jacob were buried in a place called Rocky Hollow in Walker County. The individual who purchased the land several years ago (before 2000) bulldozed the graves.

Notes for JEFFERSON JAKE PHILLIPS:

Alford B. Phillips grandfather, Jacob Phillips, was a Virginian, who coming West,

lived for a time in Tennessee with his parents and was still only four years of age when the family located in Walker County, Alabama. He remained there engaged in farming and planting until his death. He married a Miss Henson. [History of Alabama and Her People, 1927 - listing for Alford B. Phillips, Vol III]

According to the information on Jefferson Phillips in the History of Alabama and Her People, 1927, Jefferson and his parents would have moved to Alabama about 1812. They probably moved between 1816, when brother Stephen was born in Tennessee, and 1820, when brother Burton was born in Alabama.

In the 1830 Census, Jacob Phillips is living in Walker County, Alabama, next door to his father Robert Phillips. In the house are 1 male under 5 (probably an unknown son who died early), 1 male between 20 & 30 (Jacob), and 1 female between 20 & 30 (wife Mary). Jacob does not own any slaves.

In the 1840 Census, Jefferson Phillips is living in Walker County next door to his father Robert Phillips and brother G. W. Phillips. Living in the house are 2 males under 5 (Jefferson & an unknown child), 2 males age 5-10 (Martin & Robert), 1 male age 10-15, 1 male 30-40 (Jefferson), 2 females age 5-10, and one female age 30-40. Jefferson does not own any slaves.

In the 1850 Census, Jefferson is living in Walker County. He is 42 years old (born abt 1808), and born in Tennessee. He is a farmer, and lists the value of his real estate as \$600. Living with him are his wife Mary, 42 & also born in Tennessee, Martin M, 20, Robert A, 19, Abigail, 16, Elisabeth, 14, Jefferson, 11, John W, 10, Charles V, 8, Stephen B, 6, daughter Emaby?, 4, and Sophilia, 3. All the children were born in Alabama.

In the 1860 Census, Jefferson is living in the Eastern District of Walker County, in the area near Democrat. He is 51 years old, born in Tennessee, and a farmer. The value of his real estate is \$1000, and his personal estate \$2195. Living with him are Robert D, 27, Agil (Abigail), 25, Jefferson L, 21, John W, 19, Charles V, 17, Steven B, 16, Emily, 13, Sophilia B, 10, and Eli J, 7. Jefferson's wife Mary must have died between the birth of Eli, about 1853, and the census in July 1860.

In the 1880 Census, Jefferson Phillips, Sr, is living in Walker County in Beat 16. Although the census lists him as a separate household in the house/dwelling of James L and Sophelia Sanders, Jefferson is living with his daughter Sophelia. Jefferson is 71, widowed, and a farmer. He was born in Tennessee and his parents were born in Virginia.

There is a military memorial headstone in the Phillips Freewill Baptist Cemetery in Walker Co, Alabama, for Jefferson Phillips, 1808 - 1892. It is located with other military memorial headstones for his brothers, Bruton (?), Charles, Stephen, and George. The birth year is consistent with his brothers. This date is also consistent with the Census.

According to Katherine Southard, Jacob was buried in a place called Rocky Hollow in Walker County. The individual who purchased the land several years ago (before 2000) bulldozed the graves. Jacob's father was also buried there.

Notes for CHARLES ALVIE PHILLIPS:

In the 1840 Census, Charles Philips is living in Walker County, Alabama. Living in the house are 1 male under 5, 1 male between 20 & 30, and 1 female age 10-15. Charles does not own any slaves.

In the 1850 Census, Charles is living in Walker County. He is 28 (should be 38). Living with him are his wife Cyntha, 26, and children William, 11, Madison, 8, Jefferson, 6, Gabriel, 4, John M, 1, and Patsy, 2 months. Patsy appears to have been born in Tennessee, although this could be the birthplace for her uncle Bruton on the next line of the census.

Charles is living close to his brothers George, Bruton, and Stephen.

In the 1860 Census, Charles is living in the Eastern Division of Walker County, near the town of Democrat. He is 43 years old, born in Tennessee, and a farmer. The value of his real estate is \$300, and his personal estate \$705. Living with him are his wife Syntha, 43, and born in Tennessee. Syntha is illiterate. Also with them are their children William, 20, James M, 18, Jefferson, 16, Gabrel, 13, John M, 10, Rily, 8, Martha, 5, and Abraham L, one month (born in June). All the children were born in Alabama. Patsy, 2 months old in 1850, appears to have died while young.

There is a military memorial headstone in the Phillips Freewill Baptist Cemetery in Walker Co, Alabama, for Charles Phillips, 1818 - 1890. It is located with other military memorial headstones for his brothers, Bruton (?), Stephen, George, and Jefferson. The birth year is consistent with his brothers.

In the 1840 Census, G. W. Phillips is living in Walker County, Alabama, next door to his father Robert and brother Jefferson. Living in the house are 1 male under 5, 1 male

age 20-30, 1 female under 5, and one female age 20-30. George does not own any slaves.

In the 1850 Census, George W Phillips is living in Walker County. He is 36 years old and a farmer. The value of his real estate is \$300. Living with him are his wife Elisabeth, 30, born in Kentucky, and children John H, 13, Nancy, 10, Mary Ann, 7, George W, 4, and Soloman, 2. All the children were born in Alabama. Also living with them is Robert Phillips, age 61, farmer, and born in Virginia. George is living close to his brothers Bruton, Charles, and Stephen.

In the 1860 Census, G W Phillips is living in the Eastern Division of Walker County, near the town of Democrat. He is 47 years old, born in Tennessee, and a farmer. The value of his real estate is \$800, and his personal estate \$884. Living with him are his wife Elizabeth, 40, born in Kentucky. Elizabeth is illiterate. Also living with them are their children John H, 21, Nancy, 20, Mary A, 18, George W, 14, Soloman, 12, Elizabeth, 9, Sarah, 6, and Malissa, 1. All the children were born in Alabama.

In the 1880 Census, George W Phillips is living in Beat 16 of Walker County. He is 66 years old, a farmer, and was born in Tennessee. Living with him is his wife Elizabeth, 61, born in Kentucky. She is illiterate. Also with them are their children Nancy, 40, Sarah M, 24, Malisa C, 20, and Jefferson D, 18. All were born in Alabama.

There is a military memorial headstone in the Phillips Freewill Baptist Cemetery in Walker Co, Alabama, for George W. Phillips, 1814 - 1872. It is located with other military memorial headstones for his brothers, Bruton (?), Stephen, George, and Jefferson. The birth year is consistent with his brothers.

Notes for STEPHEN PHILLIPS:

In the 1850 Census, Stephen Phillips is living in Walker County, Alabama. He is 34 years old, born in Tennessee, and a farmer. Living with him are his wife Lucinda, 24 and born in South Carolina, and their children Martha, 7, Thomas, 2, and Lucinda, 1. All the children were born in Alabama. Stephen is living close to his brothers George, Charles, and Bruton.

In the 1860 Census, Stevens Phillips is living in the Eastern Division of Walker County, near Democrat. He is 45 years old, born in Tennessee, and a farmer. The value of his real estate is \$200 and his personal estate \$345. Living with him are his wife Lucinda, 35, born in South Carolina, Martha F, 13, Thomas M, 12, Lucinda C, 9,

Mallissa, 7, and Darliw T, 6. All the children were born in Alabama. Hopefully, Lucinda is the same Lucinda, age 1, on the 1850 Census.

There is a military memorial headstone in the Phillips Freewill Baptist Cemetery in Walker Co, Alabama, for Stephen Phillips, 1816 - 1874. It is located with other military memorial headstones for his brothers, Bruton (?), Charles, George, and Jefferson. The birth year is consistent with his brothers.

Notes for LUCINDA:

In the 1880 Census, Lucinda Philips is living in Walker County, Alabama, in Beat 16. She is 67 years old, and was born in Alabama. She is a farmer. Living with her is her daughter Malisa, 26. Also living with them is Lucinda's son Thomas and his family. Thomas is listed as a separate family in the same house.

It is located with other military memorial headstones for his brothers, Charles, Stephen, George, and Jefferson. The birth year is somewhat inconsistent with his brothers, but not entirely out of line. His mother Abigail would have been 45 in 1830, and could have born a child then.

In the 1850 Census, Bruton Phillips is living in Walker County, Alabama. He is 29 years old, born in Alabama, and a farmer. He is illiterate. Living with his are his wife Mary, 28, born in North Carolina, and their children Charles, 9, William, 8, James, 6, and Robert, 4. All the children were born in Alabama. Bruton is living close to his brothers George, Charles, and Stephen.

In the 1860 Census, Bruton Phillips is living in the Eastern Division of Walker County, near the town of Democrat. He is 38 years old, born in Alabama, and a farmer. Bruton is illiterate. The value of his real estate is \$500, and his personal estate \$218. Living with him are his wife Mary, 34 and born in North Carolina, and their children Charley, 18, William R, 16, James, 15, Roberts, 13, Abby, 7, Willis J, 6, and Sarah E, 4. All the children were born in Alabama.

In the 1880 Census, Bouton Philips is living in Walker County, in Beat 16. He is a farmer, 58 years old, and was born in Alabama. His parents were born in Virginia and Tennessee. Living with him are his wife Mary, 50, born in North Carolina, and their children, Charley, 37, Abby, 28, and Sarah E, 24. Charley is listed on the census as idiotic.

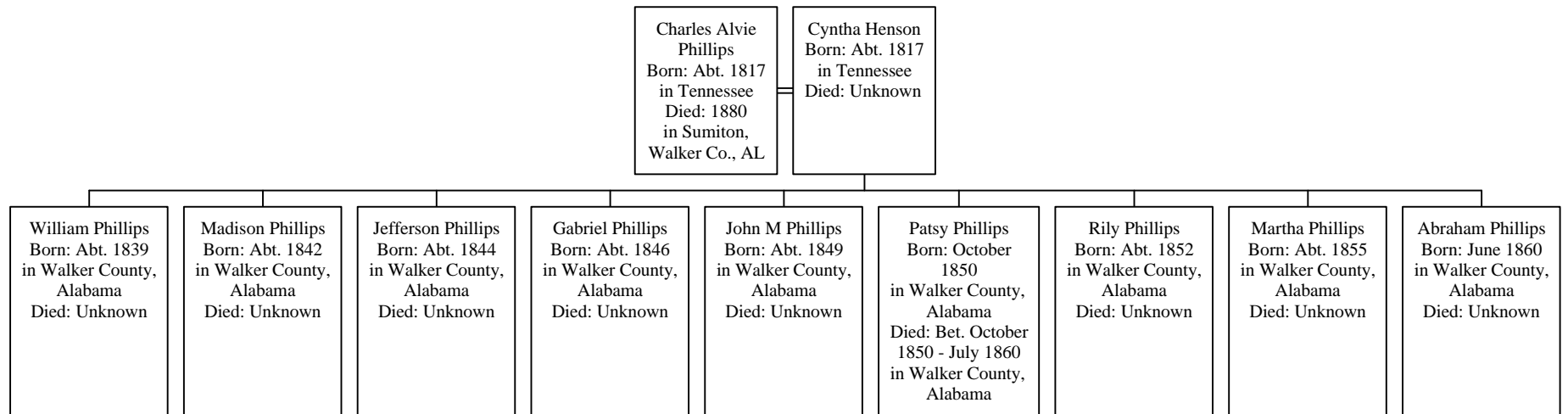

Phillips grandfather, Jacob Phillips, was a Virginian, who coming West, lived for a time in Tennessee with his parents and was still only four years of age when the family located in Walker County, Alabama. He remained there engaged in farming and planting until his death. He married a Miss Henson. [History of Alabama and Her People, 1927 - listing for Alford B. Phillips, Vol III]

According to the information on Jefferson Phillips in the History of Alabama and Her People, 1927, Jefferson and his parents would have moved to Alabama about 1812. They probably moved between 1816, when brother Stephen was born in Tennessee, and 1820, when brother Burton was born in Alabama.

In the 1830 Census, Jacob Phillips is living in Walker County, Alabama, next door to his father Robert Phillips. In the house are 1 male under 5 (probably an unknown son who died early), 1 male between 20 & 30 (Jacob), and 1 female between 20 & 30 (wife Mary). Jacob does not own any slaves.

In the 1840 Census, Jefferson Phillips is living in Walker County next door to his father Robert Phillips and brother G. W. Phillips. Living in the house are 2 males under 5 (Jefferson & an unknown child), 2 males age 5-10 (Martin & Robert), 1 male age 10-15, 1 male 30-40 (Jefferson), 2 females age 5-10, and one female age 30-40. Jefferson does not own any slaves.

In the 1850 Census, Jefferson is living in Walker County. He is 42 years old (born abt 1808), and born in Tennessee. He is a farmer, and lists the value of his real estate as \$600. Living with him are his wife Mary, 42 & also born in Tennessee, Martin M, 20, Robert A, 19, Abigail, 16, Elisabeth, 14, Jefferson, 11, John W, 10, Charles V, 8, Stephen B, 6, daughter Emaby?, 4, and Sophilia, 3. All the children were born in Alabama.

In the 1860 Census, Jefferson is living in the Eastern District of Walker County, in the area near Democrat. He is 51 years old, born in Tennessee, and a farmer. The value of his real estate is \$1000, and his personal estate \$2195. Living with him are Robert D, 27, Agil (Abigail), 25, Jefferson L, 21, John W, 19, Charles V, 17, Steven B, 16, Emily, 13, Sophilia B, 10, and Eli J, 7. Jefferson's wife Mary must have died between the birth of Eli, about 1853, and the census in July 1860.

In the 1880 Census, Jefferson Phillips, Sr, is living in Walker County in Beat 16. Although the census lists him as a separate household in the house/dwelling of James L and Sophelia Sanders, Jefferson is living with his daughter Sophelia. Jefferson is 71, widowed, and a farmer. He was born in Tennessee and his parents were born in Virginia.

There is a military memorial headstone in the Phillips Freewill Baptist Cemetery in Walker Co, Alabama, for Jefferson Phillips, 1808 - 1892. It is located with other military memorial headstones for his brothers, Bruton (?), Charles, Stephen, and George. The birth year is consistent with his brothers. This date is also consistent with the Census.

According to Katherine Southard, Jacob was buried in a place called Rocky Hollow in Walker County.

The individual who purchased the land several years ago (before 2000) bulldozed the graves. Jacob's father was also buried there.

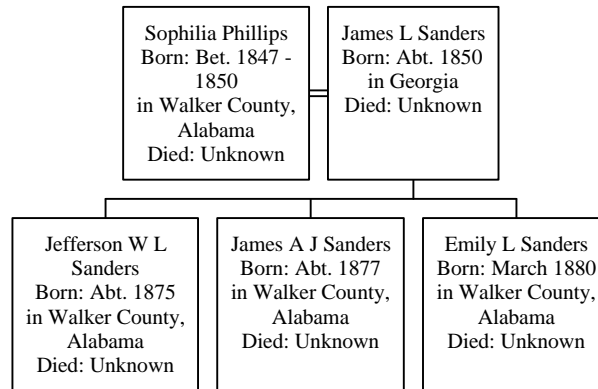

Martin Marion Phillips was born in Walker County in 1828. He lived there all his life, and about 1868 established his home two miles south of the fork of the Mulberry and Sipsey Rivers. He died at Dora February 5, 1902. For many years he held the post of justice of the peace, was a soldier of the Confederacy throughout the war between the states, was an active Democrat, a Baptist and a Mason. He married Elizabeth Fields, who was born near old Elyton, now the city of Birmingham in Jefferson County and died at the village of Democrat, Walker County. Martin served in the Confederate Army, Co. F 56, Regiment , Alabama - Cavalry, under the command of Elijah Rices [Katherine Southard] [Phillips.FTW]

In the 1860 Census, Martin is living in the Eastern Division of Walker County, near the town of Democrat. He is 29 years old and a farmer. Living with him is his wife Elizabeth, 18. They were married within the year (census taken in July).

In the 1880 Census, Martin, a farmer age 47, and Elizabeth, age 37, were living in Beat 16, Walker Co., Alabama, with their three children, Alfred B, age 19 and a schoolteacher, John V., age 18 and also teaching school, and Mary E, age 14.

In the 1900 Census, Martin is widowed and living with his son John, his wife Lillian, and their 4 children. Also in the household are two lodgers or boarders, Eliza J. Thomas, age 62, and James S. Grilleland, age 41. Living next door is Martin's brother Robert.

Notes for DR. ALFORD BYRD PHILLIPS:

Dr. Phillips remembered as a boy when Wilson's Raiders come to his family's farm in 1864. They stole meat from the smokehouse, threw all the clothes on the floor and poured sorgam syrup over them. The negro servant had hidden the horses in the canebreak by the river. He had tied them so tight that all but two broke their necks struggling against the ropes. He also remembered they wove their own linsey-woolsey cloth during the war, and what a treat it was to dress up in his linsey-woolsey suit to go with the negro servant to Warrior to sell the cotton. [Catharine Phillips Hager, daughter] As none of the census takers from 1830 to 1860 recorded any slaves for any of the Phillips's, I think the inclusion of slaves in this story is a little suspect. [CAR]

In 1880, Alford was a school teacher. [1880 Census]

Dr. Phillips was born on a farm two miles south of the fork of the Mulberry and Sipsey Rivers in Walker County, November 23, 1861.

Alford Byrd Phillips grew up on the home farm, attended common schools, completed his high school education in Jefferson County under Professor M. V. Henry and had his professional training at Vanderbilt University at Nashville, where he graduated M.D. in 1883. After graduating he practiced two years and three months in Walker County and from 1885 to 1889 was located at Trenton in Phillips County, Arkansas. It was in 1889 that he established his permanent home at Dora, and since that date has been unflagging in attention to his duties as physician and surgeon, with a practice extending over a large area in Walker and Jefferson counties. He is a local surgeon for Pratt Fuel Corporation, with offices at Yerkwood and Burnwell, now called Beachy Hollow, and also at Red Star.

Doctor Phillips has his home and offices, with a full equipment of the drugs required

in his practice, at Dora. For fifteen years he was a member of the City Council of Dora, is a democrat, and was a charter member of the Dora Banking & Trust Company, served as its president and is still one of the stockholders and directors. He is a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, and in Masonry is affiliated with Davis Fraternal Lodge No. 483, F. and A. M., at Dora, Alabama Consistory No. 1 of the Scottish Rite and Kamram Grotto of Masons at Birmingham, also Zamora Temple of the Mystic Shrine at Birmingham. He is member of the Walker County Medical Society and the Alabama State Medical Society and is a former fellow of the American Medical Association. During the World war he was liberal of his means in contributing to the war causes and the support of orphans of deceased soldiers. [History of Alabama and Her People, 1927 - listing for Alford B. From the 1900 and 1910 censuses, it appears Alford had an earlier marriage and was a widower by 1900.

On May 26 1895, A. B. Phillips married S. B. McConbrey in Walker County. [1] It is very likely that this is Alford and his first wife. Alford was back in Walker County from Arkansas in 1889, so he was living there in at this time. A review of the 1900 Census did not turn up any candidates for this couple, supporting the theory that S. B. McConbrey is Alford's first wife and she died before 1900.

In the 1900 Census, Alford B Phillips is living in Horse Creek, Walker Co, Alabama. He is a boarder in the house of Henry J Dollar. Alford is 38 years old and a physician. His marital status is single, but it also looks like the census taker wrote "wd" (widowed) in the next column.

In the 1910 Census, Alfred B Phillips is living on Main Street in Dora, Walker Co, Alabama. He is 48 years old and a physician in general practice. Living with him are his wife Maggie, 31, son A. B., 3, and daughter Katherine, 11 months. On the census, this is Alford's second marriage; it is Maggie's first. They have been married for 4 years. Maggie has had two children and both are living. Maggie's brother John Terry and his wife are living next door, and Alford's brother John is living just down the street.

In the 1920 Census, Dr Phillips is living at the Burnwell Mine, near Dora, in Walker Co. He is 59 years old and a medical doctor. Living with him are his wife Margaret, age 40, and children Alford Jr, 13, and Catherine, 11.

In the 1930 Census, Dr Phillips is living in Dora, Walker Co, Alabama. He is 68 years old, and a medical doctor in general practice. Living with him are his wife Maggie, age 52, and daughter Katherine, 21. Catharine is attending school.

Dr. Phillips' office in Dora was downtown on the side of the street with the creek behind it. There was steep hill down to the creek from the street, so the buildings were supported by stilts at the back. [JHR]

Family stories say Dr. Phillips practiced medicine during the week at Helena, Arkansas, and on the weekends he rode the river boats of the Mississippi gambling before returning to Alabama to live and practice medicine.

Dr. Phillips was one of the first original stockholders of the Dora Banking and Trust Company, serving as its president for three years (1919-1922). [Katherine Southard]

Margaret Terry was born in Georgia and was a popular school teacher in her native state and also in Jefferson County, Alabama. [1]

Margaret was educated at Locust Grove Institute, and taught in the public schools of Georgia and Jonesboro, Alabama. [2]

In the 1900 Census, Maggie is living in Milners Crossroads District, Harris County, Georgia, with her parents, 5 siblings, and 4 nieces and nephews. She is a school teacher.

Margaret Phillips and her husband Dr. Alford Phillips were so well regarded in the community that in the early 1940's when Mrs. Phillips wanted to go shopping in Birmingham she would call the bus company, and they would reroute a bus by her house to pick her up. [Katherine Southard] Granddaughter Jane remembers walking from Granny's house to the train tracks where the train would stop and pick them up.

Granny Phillips had chickens and a strawberry patch at her house in Dora. There was also a china berry tree, and when the berries fell off they turned your feet purple when you walked barefoot in the yard. When she was 5 or 6 years old, granddaughter Jane remembers Granny had a field of cotton that Jane and Sara helped pick. It was high cotton, not the lower growing cotton that is grown today. Sara's hair got all full of cockle burrs while they were picking cotton. Jane remembers churning butter on the back porch. Granny had two stoves, a giant wood-burning stove that she used in winter because it helped heat the house, and an electric stove. After Dr. Phillips died in 1935, Granny rented out the back bedrooms to school teachers. Jane remembers that Granny had a beautiful set of painted furniture in the front bedroom. She had a bed, dresser, and dressing table painted pale green with flowers.

Margaret was a quilter, and four of her quilts still exist. She made two Dresden plate quilts in a similar color scheme (yellow). One included scraps from granddaughter Jane's baby and toddler clothes, and is owned by great-granddaughter Catherine Reuther. Catherine also owns a second quilt made of small square blocks pieced in a log-cabin block style. Granddaughter Sara Hager Moxley owns a Grandmother's Flower Garden made with small hexagon patches. This quilt may have been quilted after Maggie died. The other Dresden Plate quilt is owned by great-granddaughter

Elizabeth Moxley Penrod or Frances Moxley Zinder.

After she died, a lot of things in the house, including Dr. Phillips' medical books, were put into a large pile and burned. [JHR]

According to granddaughter Jane Hager Reuther, Margaret (Granny) was in the hospital in Birmingham when she died.

In the 1910 Census, H B Gravlee is living in Dora, Walker Co, Alabama. He is 49 years old and a justice of the peace. Living with him is his wife Etta, 44. They have been married 28 years, and Etta has had five children, four are still living. Also living with them are their sons Dow, 25, a coal inspector for the rail road, and Alf, 22, a coal miner.

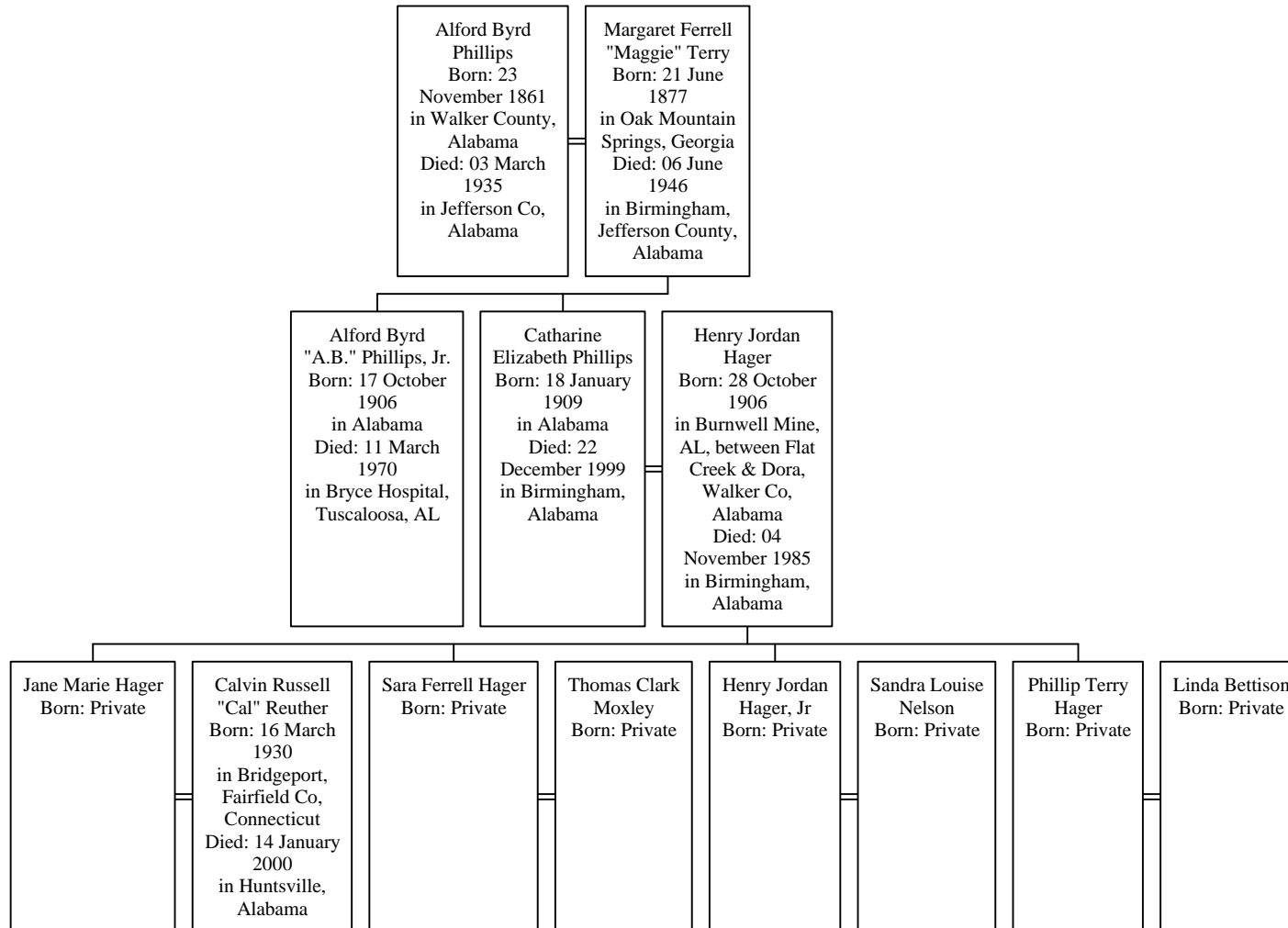

ALFORD BYRD⁸ PHILLIPS (*MARTIN MARION⁷, JEFFERSON JAKE⁶, ROBERT⁵, TOBIAS⁴, GEORGE³, TOBIAS², JOHN¹*) was born 23 November 1861 in Walker County, Alabama, and died 03 March 1935 in Jefferson Co, Alabama^{1,2}. He married MARGARET FERRELL TERRY 23 December 1906 in Bessemer, Jefferson Co, Alabama³, daughter of JOHN TERRY and MARY GRIFFIN. She was born 21 June 1877 in Oak Mountain Springs, Georgia, and died 06 June 1946 in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama^{4,5}.

Notes for DR. ALFORD BYRD PHILLIPS:

Dr. Phillips remembered as a boy when Wilson's Raiders come to his family's farm in 1864. They stole meat from the smokehouse, threw all the clothes on the floor and poured sorgam syrup over them. The negro servant had hidden the horses in the canebreak by the river. He had tied them so tight that all but two broke their necks struggling against the ropes. He also remembered they wove their own linsey-woolsey cloth during the war, and what a treat it was to dress up in his linsey-woolsey suit to go with the negro servant to Warrior to sell the cotton. [Catharine Phillips Hager, daughter] As none of the census takers from 1830 to 1860 recorded any slaves for any of the Phillips's, I think the inclusion of slaves in this story is a little suspect. [CAR]

In 1880, Alford was a school teacher. [1880 Census]

Dr. Phillips was born on a farm two miles south of the fork of the Mulberry and Sipsey Rivers in Walker County, November 23, 1861.

Alford Byrd Phillips grew up on the home farm, attended common schools, completed his high school education in Jefferson County under Professor M. V. Henry and had his professional training at Vanderbilt University at Nashville, where he graduated M.D. in 1883. After graduating he practiced two years and three months in Walker County and from 1885 to 1889 was located at Trenton in Phillips County, Arkansas. It was in 1889 that he established his permanent home at Dora, and since that date has been unflagging in attention to his duties as physician and surgeon, with a practice extending over a large area in Walker and Jefferson counties. He is a local surgeon for Pratt Fuel Corporation, with offices at Yerewood and Burnwell, now called Beachy Hollow, and also at Red Star.

Doctor Phillips has his home and offices, with a full equipment of the drugs required in his practice, at Dora. For fifteen years he was a member of the City Council of Dora, is a democrat, and was a charter member of the Dora Banking & Trust Company, served as its president and is still one of the stockholders and directors. He is a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, and in Masonry is affiliated with Davis Fraternal Lodge No. 483, F. and A. M., at Dora, Alabama Consistory No. 1 of the Scottish Rite and Kamram Grotto of Masons at Birmingham, also Zamora Temple of the Mystic Shrine at Birmingham. He is member of the Walker County Medical Society and the Alabama State Medical Society and is a former fellow of the American Medical Association. During the World war he was liberal of his means in contributing to the war causes and the support of orphans of deceased soldiers.

From the 1900 and 1910 censuses, it appears Alford had an earlier marriage and was a widower by 1900.

On May 26 1895, A. B. Phillips married S. B. McConbrey in Walker County. [1] It is very likely that this is Alford and his first wife. Alford was back in Walker County from Arkansas in 1889, so he was living there in at this time. A review of the 1900 Census did not turn up any candidates for this couple,

supporting the theory that S. B. McConbrey is Alford's first wife and she died before 1900.

In the 1900 Census, Alford B Phillips is living in Horse Creek, Walker Co, Alabama. He is a boarder in the house of Henry J Dollar. Alford is 38 years old and a physician. His marital status is single, but it also looks like the census taker wrote "wd" (widowed) in the next column.

In the 1910 Census, Alfred B Phillips is living on Main Street in Dora, Walker Co, Alabama. He is 48 years old and a physician in general practice. Living with him are his wife Maggie, 31, son A. B., 3, and daughter Katherine, 11 months. On the census, this is Alford's second marriage; it is Maggie's first. They have been married for 4 years. Maggie has had two children and both are living. Maggie's brother John Terry and his wife are living next door, and Alford's brother John is living just down the street.

In the 1920 Census, Dr Phillips is living at the Burnwell Mine, near Dora, in Walker Co. He is 59 years old and a medical doctor. Living with him are his wife Margaret, age 40, and children Alford Jr, 13, and Catherine, 11.

In the 1930 Census, Dr Phillips is living in Dora, Walker Co, Alabama. He is 68 years old, and a medical doctor in general practice. Living with him are his wife Maggie, age 52, and daughter Katherine, 21. Catharine is attending school.

Dr. Phillips' office in Dora was downtown on the side of the street with the creek behind it. There was steep hill down to the creek from the street, so the buildings were supported by stilts at the back. [JHR]

Family stories say Dr. Phillips practiced medicine during the week at Helena, Arkansas, and on the weekends he rode the river boats of the Mississippi gambling before returning to Alabama to live and practice medicine.

Dr. Phillips was one of the first original stockholders of the Dora Banking and Trust Company, serving as its president for three years (1919-1922). [Katherine Southard]

Alfred B Phillips died in March 1935 in Jefferson County, Alabama. [2]

Notes for MARGARET FERRELL TERRY:

Margaret Terry was born in Georgia and was a popular school teacher in her native state and also in

Jefferson County, Alabama. [1]

Margaret was educated at Locust Grove Institute, and taught in the public schools of Georgia and Jonesboro, Alabama. [2]

In the 1900 Census, Maggie is living in Milners Crossroads District, Harris County, Georgia, with her parents, 5 siblings, and 4 nieces and nephews. She is a school teacher.

Margaret Phillips and her husband Dr. Alford Phillips were so well regarded in the community that in the early 1940's when Mrs. Phillips wanted to go shopping in Birmingham she would call the bus company, and they would reroute a bus by her house to pick her up. [Katherine Southard]
Granddaughter Jane remembers walking from Granny's house to the train tracks where the train would stop and pick them up.

Granny Phillips had chickens and a strawberry patch at her house in Dora. There was also a china berry tree, and when the berries fell off they turned your feet purple when you walked barefoot in the yard. When she was 5 or 6 years old, granddaughter Jane remembers Granny had a field of cotton that Jane and Sara helped pick. It was high cotton, not the lower growing cotton that is grown today. Sara's hair got all full of cockle burrs while they were picking cotton. Jane remembers churning butter on the back porch. Granny had two stoves, a giant wood-burning stove that she used in winter because it helped heat the house, and an electric stove. After Dr. Phillips died in 1935, Granny rented out the back bedrooms to school teachers. Jane remembers that Granny had a beautiful set of painted furniture in the front bedroom. She had a bed, dresser, and dressing table painted pale green with flowers.

Margaret was a quilter, and four of her quilts still exist. She made two Dresden plate quilts in a similar color scheme (yellow). One included scraps from granddaughter Jane's baby and toddler clothes, and is owned by great-granddaughter Catherine Reuther. Catherine also owns a second quilt made of small square blocks pieced in a log-cabin block style. Granddaughter Sara Hager Moxley owns a Grandmother's Flower Garden made with small hexagon patches. This quilt may have been quilted after Maggie died. The other Dresden Plate quilt is owned by great-granddaughter Elizabeth Moxley Penrod or Frances Moxley Zinder.

After she died, a lot of things in the house, including Dr. Phillips' medical books, were put into a large pile and burned. [JHR]

According to granddaughter Jane Hager Reuther, Margaret (Granny) was in the hospital in Birmingham when she died.

Maggie T Phillips died 06 Jun 1946 in Jefferson County. [3]

Notes for ALFORD BYRD PHILLIPS, JR.:

A.B. contracted syphilis about 1926, and was uncooperative in the treatment prescribed by his father and other doctors, including his uncle Dr. L.L. Terry.

He had attended Alabama Polytechnic Institute (now Auburn University). He had been a bookkeeper for the Chevrolet people, and then was a bookkeeper at Dora Motor Company, which Dr. Phillips had a half interest in.

About 1928, A. B. became moody and depressed. He lost interest in his work and became careless in his dress. He had obsessed ideas and hallucinations, and once or twice threatened suicide. He was suspicious, and thought his father and mother were taking his mind away. He became untruthful, and at times vulgar and profane. He was in the hospital for three weeks where his mental condition greatly improved, but on returning home, refused treatment. In August 1928 he was then confined to Hill Crest Sanitarium in Birmingham.

In October 1928, A.B.'s condition was taken before the court and he was committed to the state hospital, Bryce in Tuscaloosa. He was brought to the hospital by his cousins Joe Phillips and W. W. Phillips, most likely Joseph Phillips and William Jefferson Phillips, the sons of Jefferson Lawrence Phillips, brother to Martin Marion Phillips, Dr. A. B. Phillips' father.

The doctors at Bryce diagnosed A.B. as having Dementia Praecox - Hebephrenic Type. This was later updated to more current terminology of Schizophrenic Reaction, Hebephrenic Type. According to the correspondence in the Bryce Hospital records, A.B.'s doctors at Bryce did treat him for syphilis using the available treatment of Salvarsan, since this was before penicillin was available, but they did not think his syphilis was the cause of his mental illness. Hebephrenic schizophrenia is today defined as a form of schizophrenia characterized by severe disintegration of personality including erratic speech and childish mannerisms and bizarre behavior. It usually becomes evident during puberty, and is the most common diagnostic category in mental institutions.

A.B. spent the remainder of his life at Bryce Hospital. He was described in the medical records as being delusional, suffering hallucinations, being silly at times, laughing for no apparent reason. He apparently suffered a cerebral thrombosis in January 1970, and passed away March 11, 1970.

The correspondence in the Bryce Hospital file included letters from A.B.'s parents to his doctor. Often they were sending money and/or requesting a special meal for him. In February 1931, Dr. Phillips wrote to Dr. Partlow - "How is my boy A. B. Phillips Jr?". Just those few words seemed to express how heart-rending A.B.'s illness was for the family.

Upon the death of his parents, Henry Hager, A.B.'s brother-in-law, became his guardian.

Jane Hager Reuther remembers that sometime after A.B.'s funeral, Catharine Phillips

Hager told her that the woman who had been A.B.'s girlfriend or fiancée when he was committed to Bryce had come to the funeral. [Catherine Reuther August 2000]

In her younger days, Catharine was an artist. She painted china, as well as drawing and painting. Only 1 drawing and 2 paintings survive. Catharine left most of her artwork at Judson when she left school. A drawing of a teapot executed when she was 9 is owned by daughter Jane. Daughter Sara owns an oil painting of wisteria, and Phillip owns an oil painting of fruit.

Catharine taught school for a short while either before and/or after she married Henry. [Sara Moxley]

She was an excellent seamstress. Catherine could go into a store, find a dress she or her daughters liked, do a quick sketch on the street, and then go home and make the dress.

Listed as a survivor on her obituary was her sister-in-heart, Sarah Fleetwood Hendrix. She and Sarah met in the spring of 1914 when they were 5 years old, and remained lifelong and close friends. Sarah was known to all Catharine's children and grandchildren as Aunt Sarah.

When Catharine died, her daughter Sara had just bought her a nice nightgown and bed jacket for Christmas since Catharine was confined to bed. She was buried on Christmas Eve in her new nightgown.

Notes for HENRY JORDAN HAGER:

Henry was named for his uncle, Henry Jordan, his father Charles' sister Annie's husband.

When he was younger, Henry was known as Hank. As an adult most people called him Henry, but old friends still called him Hank. [Tom Moxley]

Henry attended 2nd and 3rd grades at Ira Street School in Atlanta, Georgia, while living with his Aunt

Annie Hager Jordan and Uncle Henry Jordan. Uncle Henry signed his report cards. [report cards]

When he was young, Henry hoboed on a train from West Virginia to Atlanta, and came down with appendicitis on the way and almost died. His Aunt Annie Jordan lived in Atlanta, and took him to the doctor. [Tom Moxley]

In the 1930 Census, Henry Hager was living in Birmingham, Alabama, on Highland Avenue. He was 23 years old and an engineer, working in the mechanical industry. His roommate, or lodger on the census, was D. A. York (?), 36 years old and a physician.

Henry's first job after college was at American Cast Iron Pipe Co, in the drafting office, where future in-law Stephen Moxley (father of Henry's future son-in-law) was his boss. Stephen Moxley was later president of the company. Alabama By Products, the company Henry worked for most of his life, was a major supplier to ACIPCo. [Tom Moxley]

In addition to his B.S. degree in Mining Engineering from the University of Alabama, Henry also received a Masters from the University on a research scholarship with the US Bureau of Mines. [The Hager Family, Geo-Petro Notes, Jan 1980]

The Mine Foreman Certificate of Competency that Henry received in 1939 is required in order to be an underground mine foreman in the coal industry. Underground mining is quite hazardous. [The Hager Family, Geo-Petro Notes, Jan 1980]

When I was about 5 or 6, I remember Granddaddy telling this story: Once upon a time there was a band of robbers sitting around the campfire. The leader said, "Pedro, tell us a story." Grandmother and Granddaddy would occasionally drive up to Huntsville from Birmingham. Granddaddy would come in, say Hello, have a drink of whiskey, and stand around jingling the change and keys in his pockets. He had come, said hello, and now it was time to go. Grandmother, of course, needed to sit and visit for a while. [CAR]

Henry had scars on his lungs, probably from childhood T. B. (tuberculosis). He received further scarring on his lungs in the winter of 1936 from severe pneumonia. He smoked most of his life, usually in secret. [Catharine Phillips Hager to Catherine Reuther, May 30, 1988] He died November 4, 1985, from complications after lung surgery. After surgery to remove part of his lung, a clot formed and/or broke loose and traveled to his lungs causing them to fill with fluid as if he had pneumonia. This was his second surgery to remove part of his lung. The first surgery was several years prior to the second.

During college (Auburn, AL), Cal owned and flew his own airplane, an Ercoupe.

In 1951 or 1952, Cal flew to Connecticut from Auburn through bad weather with no radio and was the only plane flying over NY. Coming back to Auburn, he developed trouble in Maryland (?). He was able to land but could not afford to fix the plane, and left it at the airport. [Jane Reuther]

During college at API Cal worked for Mr. Fortner at Jake's Joint and the Elk's Club. He met Jane at Jake's Joint. Mrs. Fortner gave Cal her recipe for Barbecue Sauce and Barbecue Basting Sauce that he used throughout his life to make fantastic barbecue chicken on the grill.

Cal graduated from Alabama Polytechnic Institute (API - later re-named Auburn University) in Auburn, Alabama, in 1953, with a Bachelors of Science degree in Electrical Engineering. His first job was across the country for Boeing in Seattle, Washington, working on the B-52 airplane. He left Boeing in 1956 for Westinghouse in Pittsburgh, PA, but was on his way back to Boeing and Seattle in 1958 when Jane was pregnant with Cathy. Just weeks after Cathy was born in September, they headed for a new assignment in Fort Walton Beach, FL, and the BOMARC missile program at Eglin AFB.

In 1963, Cal, Jane, Cathy and Russell moved to California where Cal worked on the Minuteman weapon system.

In April 1965, Cal, Jane and the children moved to Huntsville, Alabama, where Cal continued his work for Boeing, this time on the space program. He was responsible for the Boeing Saturn V

Logistics Support Staff, developing a Logistics Support Plan. He was also responsible for Saturn V Logistics activities and program schedule. In 1967 he assumed responsibility for directing the preparation of the Saturn V Flight Manual, a single source reference prepared specifically for the astronauts' use.

When Boeing reduced their operations in Huntsville in 1974 (the summer President Richard Nixon resigned and the fall Cathy got her driver's license), Cal and Jane decided to stay in Huntsville rather than be transferred to another city, and Cal went to work for Sperry Corporation on tactical missile systems at MICOM. In 1980 he began a brief stint at Guest Associates providing marketing and technical representation for technically oriented customers, as well as consultation to small business through the Small Business Administration.

In 1982, Cal went back to work for Boeing on marketing management assignments for the Air Force, MSFC, MICOM, and SSCDC customers. He retired early in 1993 after Jane's brain aneurysms and surgery that year.

Early in their marriage, when they were young and poor, Cal decided to start making furniture instead of buying it. He bought the appropriate tools and set up shop in the spare bedroom in their apartment. The first thing he made was a long low bench in the Danish Modern style. He made their bedroom furniture and later on a hi-fi cabinet, kitchen table, and a new dresser for Jane in the 1970's.

In 1983, when his mother Lydia was no longer making the family Christmas cookies, Cal took up the task, often with daughter Cathy's help. He made their favorites Springerli, Brownie Lebkuchen & Schwaben Brodli, and new ones as well. Just as Lydia did, he kept track of what he made and how many. In 2002, Cathy took up the tradition on her own. Cal also had a vegetable garden for many years, and took up canning at that time. Not only did he can vegetables, but he also made jellies and pickles.

In 1988 & 1989, Cal and Jane built a new, larger house on Mountain Springs Circle in Huntsville and moved in in April 1989. The house included a 3-car garage with large shop attached, and Jane's large weaving room over the garage and shop. After Cal's death, the house was sold to Hank and Kathy Perkins, friends from church, and a school friend (Hank) of daughter Cathy's when growing up.

Cal entered Huntsville Hospital November 25, 1999 (Thanksgiving Day) for heart bypass surgery on November 26. The surgery was successful, but numerous complications ensued due to Cal's emphysema and the steroids he had been taking for the emphysema that interfered with the healing process. After seven weeks in ICU, he passed away due to multiple organ system failure on January 14, 2000, at 5:05 PM. Daughter Cathy, son Russell, future son-in-law Bryan Kennedy, and Dr. T. Benton Washburn were present. He was buried January 18, 2000 at Maple Hill Cemetery in Huntsville.

Unknown to his family until after he entered the hospital, Cal had been having heart problems for some time. Nitroglycerin pills were found in his study for heart pain. Cal left a folder of instructions for his daughter Cathy just prior to entering the hospital in case he passed away. The information and instructions included the notice of his death to be published in the newspaper. Cathy used this almost as he had written it.

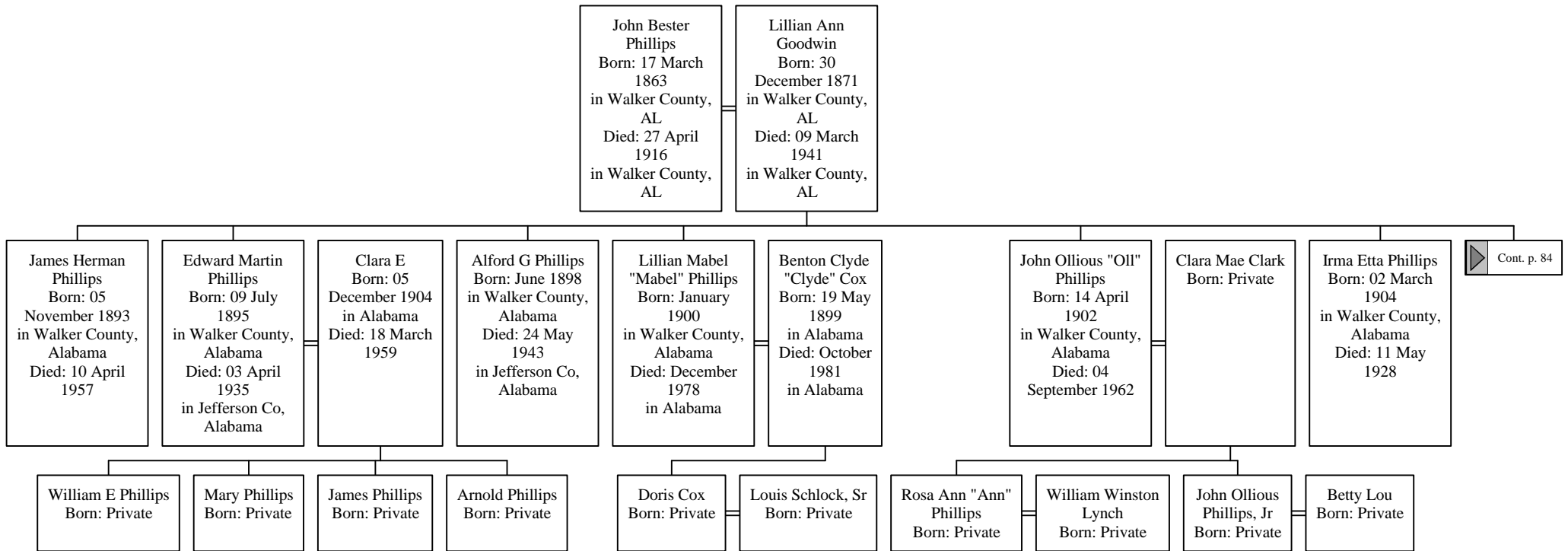

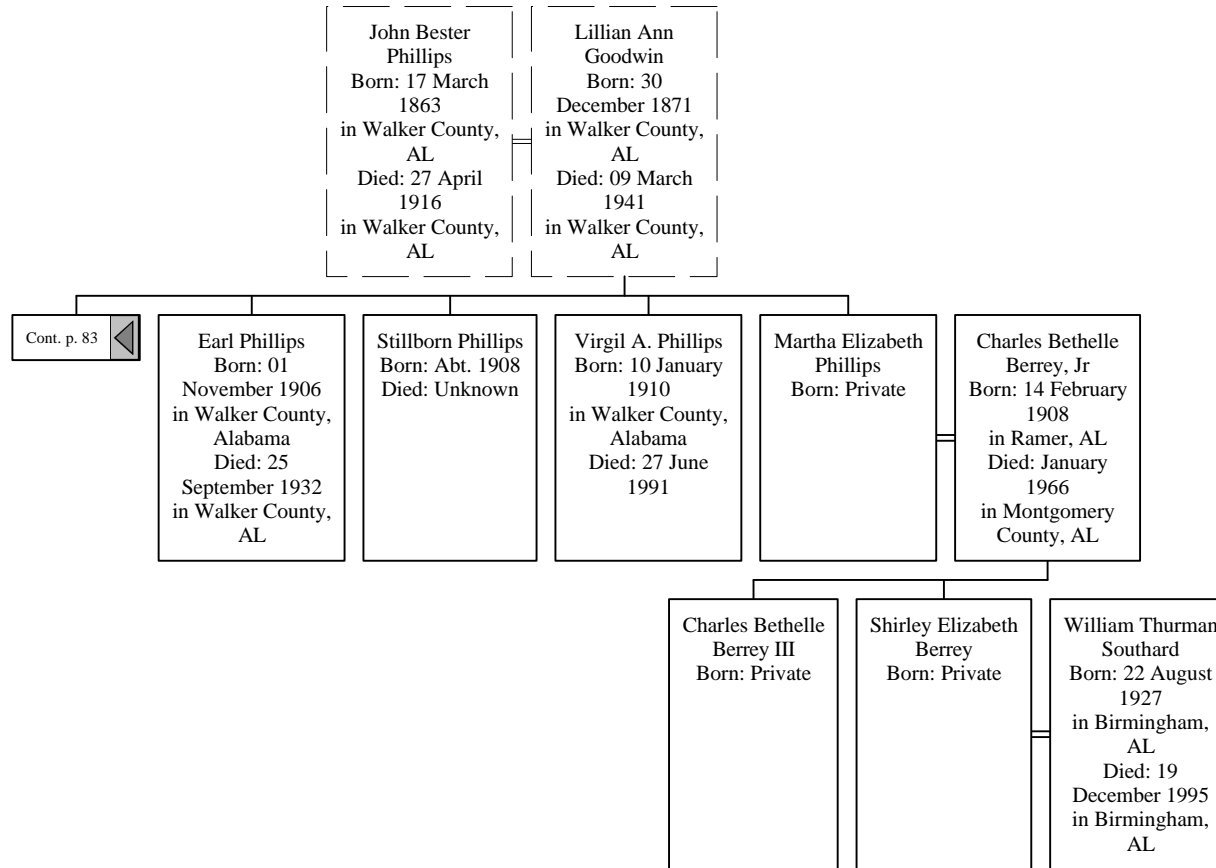

Lillian has had 4 children and all are living. Also living with them are Eliza Thomas, lodger, and James Griffenland?, boarder.

On the 1910 Census, John B Phillips is living on Main Street in Dora, Walker Co. He is 47 years old and a merchant with a general store. Living with him are his wife Lillian, 38, and children Herman, 16, Edward, 14, Alfred, 11, Lillian, 10, Olius, 8, Irma, 6, Erlin (Earl), 3, and Virgil, a few months. 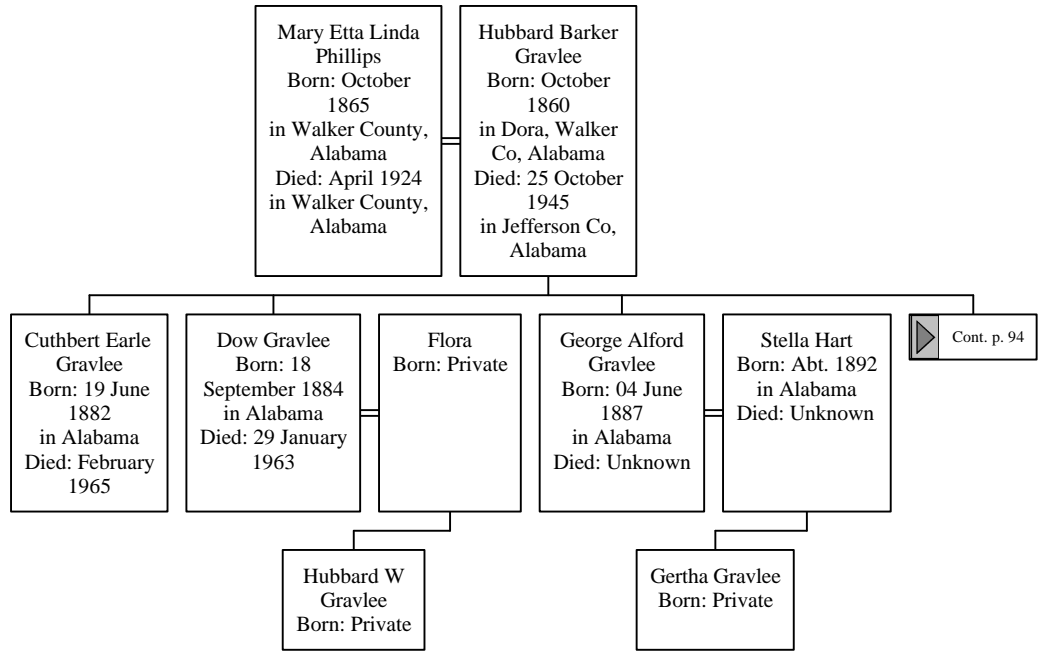

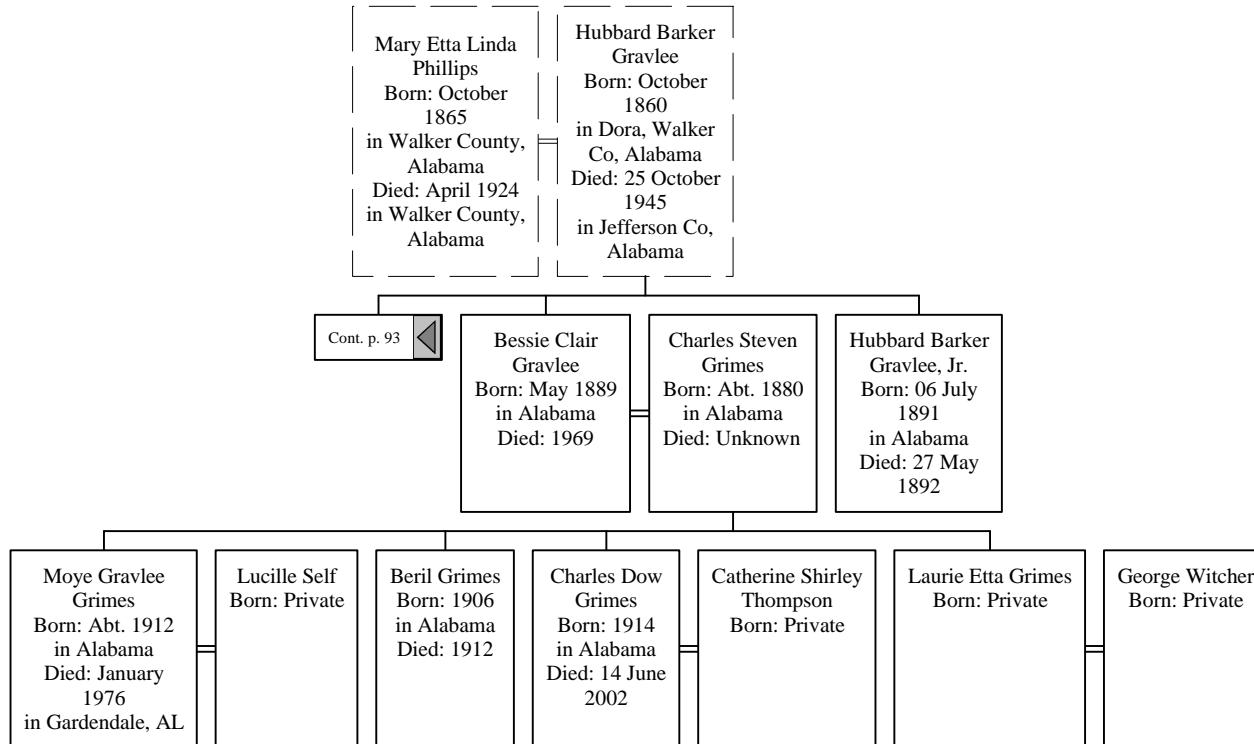
