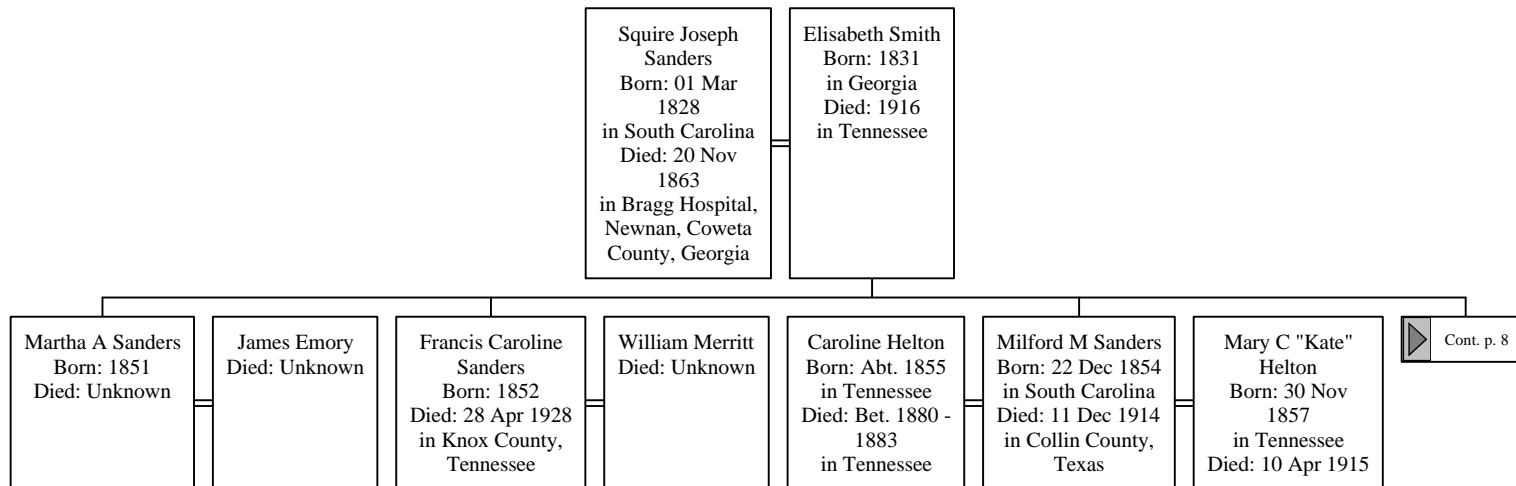

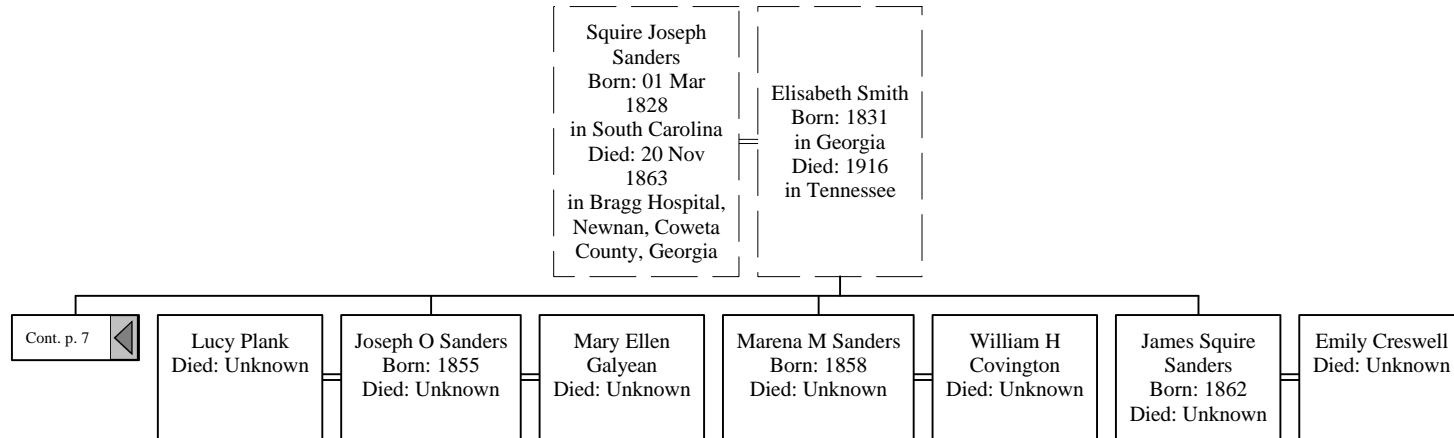

The Sanders and "The Widows' Wagon Train"

Elisabeth Smith was born in Georgia in 1831. I don't know much about her beginnings, except she had a brother, named William H. Smith. I have a letter written by William, and mailed from Cherokee County, Georgia, before the war. The letter is addressed to Squire Joseph and Elisabeth Smith Sanders in Pickens District, South Carolina. Squire and Elisabeth were married in Pickens District, in 1850. Squire and Elisabeth had 6 children, before Squire died in The War Between The States in 1863. [2nd South Carolina Rifles]. Their children were: Martha A. [born 1851], Frances C. [born 1852], Milford M. [born 1854], Joseph O. [born 1855], Marena M. [born 1858], and James "Squire" [born 1862].

After the collapse of the Confederacy, Conditions in Pickens District, now Oconee County, became violent and lawless. During the 1860s, Elisabeth Smith Sanders and several other widows moved from Pickens District to Sevier County, Tennessee, by wagon train. I know the identity of two of the other widows -- Elisabeth Sanders Emory, and Elisabeth Emory Sanders. [Confusing isn't it.] I have often wondered whom they knew in Sevier County that gave them enough confidence to load their children in wagons and make such a trip in such a time. I wonder if they thought they were in a safer place when the White Caps and Blue Bills began to terrorize Sevier County.

Once in Sevier County, the widows and their children became a part of the community and intermarried with their new neighbors. Martha J. Sanders married James Emory, son of Elisabeth Sanders Emory. Frances C. Sanders married William Lafayette Merritt, son of William T. Merritt. Milford M. Sanders married Caroline Helton and Mary C. "Kate" Helton. Joseph O. Sanders married Mary Ellen Galyean, daughter of John Franklin Galyean. Marena M. Sanders married William H. Covington. James "Squire" Sanders married Emily Catherine Creswell, daughter of Rufus M. Creswell. Elisabeth Smith Sanders married Ahas Bryan, a Union veteran, in 1890. Ahas died soon after, and Elisabeth drew his widow's pension until she died in 1916. Elisabeth Smith Sanders Bryan lost one husband in the service of the Confederacy, married a Union veteran in later life, and was widowed once again.

After Ahas died, Elisabeth built a house on her daughter and son-in law's, William and Frances Merritt, farm across the Sevier County line in Tuckahoe, Knox County, Tennessee. This community was first called French, then Tuckahoe and now Strawberry Plains. The house she built was bat and board and was known as "The Granny Bryan House". It was my first home when my father came back from World War II, and was the first home of many families just starting out. The house is gone now, but it was located on Frank Merritt Lane, off of Midway Road.

Martha Sanders married James Emory in Pickens District, South Carolina. They lived in several different communities in Sevier and surrounding counties. I don't know where they are buried, or what happened to their children, except for their son, Willis Emory, who was a Presbyterian minister. I have letters written from them in the 1890s, mailed from Boyds Creek, Luttrell, in Union County, and Concord, in Knox County.

Frances Sanders married William Merritt in Sevier County. William operated mills. I have letters from him about 1880, mailed from Newport, in Cocke County. He and Frances and some of their older children are listed in the 1880 Cocke County, census. William's occupation is listed, as miller. About 1900 they moved to Tuckahoe to work at the Tuckahoe mill. William and his sons built the Peters Mill on Kodak Road.

Milford Sanders married Caroline Helton, and after Caroline's death, married Mary C. "Kate" Helton, in Sevier County, Tennessee. I have a letter written by "M. Sanders and Kate" from

Henderson Springs. Milford and family moved to Collin County, Texas in the 1890s. Milford and Caroline had at least two children before leaving Sevier County, Wm. J., and Martha Jane. According to Helton researchers, Milford and Caroline's daughter, Martha Jane, married John Inman. Wm. J. also went to Collin County, where he married twice, and had many children.

Joseph Sanders married Mary Ellen Galyean in Sevier County. Joseph and several related families moved to Collin County, Texas. I have six letters written by Joseph from Collin County, Texas, in the 1890s. I have found descendants of John Franklin Galyean Jr., Mary Ellen's brother, in Texas. Joseph and Mary Ellen had at least three children, before leaving Sevier County: Baxter, Alexander, and Lou. After the death of Mary Ellen, Joseph remarried, and moved to Marshall County, Oklahoma. He and his new wife, Lucy Plank, had at least one child, Lillard Atchley Sanders.

Marena M. Sanders married William H. Covington in Sevier County in 1872. I have two letters written by Marena in the late 1890s, and mailed from Cocke County, Tennessee. I don't know what happened to William, Marena, and family after 1900, except for one daughter, Sarah Frances Covington, who also went to Collin County, Texas, with her Uncle Joseph, and married Joseph E. Foster.

James "Squire" Sanders married Emily Creswell in Sevier County. Squire died young leaving a widow and at least one child, Lee Roy Sanders. Emily married Hugh Randles and had several more children. Emily is buried at Boyds Creek. Lee Roy died in 1951, and is buried at Boyds Creek.

1. SQUIRE JOSEPH² SANDERS (*JAMES*¹)¹ was born 01 Mar 1828 in South Carolina², and died 20 Nov 1863 in Bragg Hospital, Newnan, Coweta County, Georgia³. He married ELISABETH SMITH⁴ 12 Sep 1850 in Pickens District, South Carolina⁵. She was born 1831 in Georgia⁶, and died 1916 in Tennessee⁶.

Notes for SQUIRE JOSEPH SANDERS:

Squire Joseph Sanders was the son of James Sanders and Eunice Caldwell. James was born abt 1789 in Chatham County, North Carolina, and died 16 Nov 1865 in Oconee County, South Carolina. Eunice was born 1787 and died in October 1870 in Oconee County, SC. [2]

The earliest known Sanders ancestors were John Sanders and Phoebe Thomas. They immigrated to the Isle of Wright County, Virginia, in the mid 1600's. [2]

Squire Sanders enlisted in Company K of the 2nd South Carolina Rifles on September 4, 1863, in Petersburg, Virginia. He died of diarrhea at Bragg Hospital in Newnan, Georgia, on November 20, 1863. [1, 3]

Notes for ELISABETH SMITH:

Elisabeth Smith was born in Georgia in 1831. I don't know much about her beginnings, except she had a brother, named William H. Smith. I have a letter written by William, and mailed from Cherokee County, Georgia, before the war. The letter is addressed to Squire Joseph and Elisabeth Smith Sanders in Pickens District, South Carolina. Squire and Elisabeth were married in Pickens District, in 1850. Squire and Elisabeth had 6 children, before Squire died in The War Between The States in 1863. [2nd South Carolina Rifles]. Their children were: Martha A. [born 1851], Frances C. [born 1852], Milford M. [born 1854], Joseph O. [born 1855], Marena M. [born 1858], and James "Squire" [born 1862]. [1]

When Elisabeth heard of her husband Squire's death in the Civil War, she left her 6 children with relatives and rode a horse 200 miles from Seneca, South Carolina, to Newnan, Georgia. Squire's name had been misspelled as Saunders on the notification, so she went to Newnan to determine if it was really him. [2]

After the collapse of the Confederacy, Conditions in Pickens District, now Oconee County, became violent and lawless. During the 1860s, Elisabeth Smith Sanders and several other widows moved from Pickens District to Sevier County, Tennessee, by wagon train. I know the identity of two of the other widows -- Elisabeth Sanders Emory, and Elisabeth Emory Sanders. [Confusing isn't it.] I have often wondered whom they knew in Sevier County that gave them enough confidence to load their children in wagons and make such a trip in such a time. I wonder if they thought they were in a safer place when the White Caps and Blue Bills began to terrorize Sevier County. [1]

When she moved to Tennessee, Elisabeth had left her farm in the hands of a caretaker. When she

returned later she found the farm occupied for several former slaves and each had a deed to the property they were on. She sued the caretaker. The records can be found in the SC Archives. [2]

Elisabeth Smith Sanders married Ahas Bryan, a Union veteran, in 1890. Ahas died soon after, and Elisabeth drew his widow's pension until she died in 1916. Elisabeth Smith Sanders Bryan lost one husband in the service of the Confederacy, married a Union veteran in later life, and was widowed once again. [1]

After Ahas died, Elisabeth built a house on her daughter and son-in law's, William and Frances Merritt, farm across the Sevier County line in Tuckahoe, Knox County, Tennessee. This community was first called French, then Tuckahoe and now Strawberry Plains. The house she built was bat and board and was known as "The Granny Bryan House". The house is gone now, but it was located on Frank Merritt Lane, off of Midway Road. [1]

Notes for MILFORD M SANDERS:

In 1880, Milford Sander is living in Waldens Creek district, Sevier County, Tennessee. He is 25 and a farmer. Milford was born in South Carolina as was his father; his mother in Georgia. Living with Milford are his wife Caroline, 25, and children Martha J, 5, and Wm J, 3. Caroline and the children were born in Tennessee. [1]

In 1900, Milford Sanders is living in Collin County, Texas (Justice Precinct 1). He is 45 and a farmer. Milford was born in South Carolina, his parents in South Carolina and Georgia. Living with Milford are his wife Mary C, 24, born in Tennessee, and a lodger, name unclear. Milford and Mary have been married 17 years. [2]

In 1910, Milford M Sanders is living in Collin County, Texas. He is 55 and a farmer. Living with Milford are his wife Katy, 52, and granddaughter Elsie Bowman, 11. Milford and Katy have been married 28 years. Katy has not had any children. Elsie was born in Texas, her parents in Illinois and Tennessee. [3]

Milford (they called him MM) was shot to death by a neighbor over a land dispute. Mildred did not remember who was said to have started the "shoot-out" or what ever happened to the neighbor but Milford was sitting in his buggy when shot. [4]

On Friday, 11 December 1914, while returning home from McKinney in Collin County, where he had gone to pay his poll tax, Milt M Sanders was shot by Gabe Crowder. The shooting occurred near Club Lake, about 16 miles south of McKinney. Gabe was arrested the next day. Milt had commented, when paying the poll tax, that it would be his last time. Perhaps he was planning to move. Milt was survived by his wife and son, who lived in Madill, Oklahoma. [5]

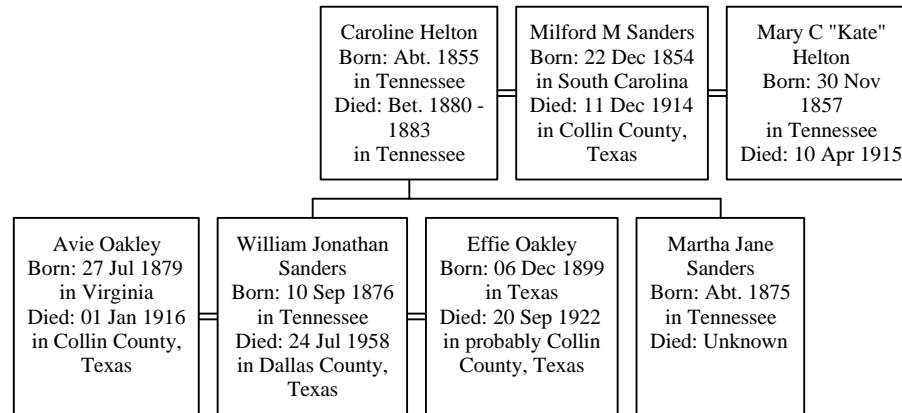

1. MILFORD M³ SANDERS (*SQUIRE JOSEPH², JAMES¹*)¹ was born 22 Dec 1854 in South Carolina^{2,3}, and died 11 Dec 1914 in Collin County, Texas^{4,5}. He married (1) CAROLINE HELTON⁶ Bet. 1870 - 1876, daughter of ROBERT HELTON and NANCY LOVEDAY. She was born Abt. 1855 in Tennessee⁷, and died Bet. 1880 - 1883 in Tennessee. He married (2) MARY C HELTON⁸ Abt. 1883⁹, daughter of THOMAS HELTON. She was born 30 Nov 1857 in Tennessee^{9,10}, and died 10 Apr 1915¹⁰.

Notes for MILFORD M SANDERS:

In 1880, Milford Sander is living in Waldens Creek district, Sevier County, Tennessee. He is 25 and a farmer. Milford was born in South Carolina as was his father; his mother in Georgia. Living with Milford are his wife Caroline, 25, and children Martha J, 5, and Wm J, 3. Caroline and the children were born in Tennessee. [1]

In 1900, Milford Sanders is living in Collin County, Texas (Justice Precinct 1). He is 45 and a farmer. Milford was born in South Carolina, his parents in South Carolina and Georgia. Living with Milford are his wife Mary C, 24, born in Tennessee, and a lodger, name unclear. Milford and Mary have been married 17 years. [2]

In 1910, Milford M Sanders is living in Collin County, Texas. He is 55 and a farmer. Living with Milford are his wife Katy, 52, and granddaughter Elsie Bowman, 11. Milford and Katy have been married 28 years. Katy has not had any children. Elsie was born in Texas, her parents in Illinois and Tennessee. [3]

Milford (they called him MM) was shot to death by a neighbor over a land dispute. Mildred did not remember who was said to have started the "shoot-out" or what ever happened to the neighbor but Milford was sitting in his buggy when shot. [4]

On Friday, 11 December 1914, while returning home from McKinney in Collin County, where he had gone to pay his poll tax, Milt M Sanders was shot by Gabe Crowder. The shooting occurred near Club Lake, about 16 miles south of McKinney. Gabe was arrested the next day. Milt had commented, when paying the poll tax, that it would be his last time. Perhaps he was planning to move. Milt was survived by his wife and son, who lived in Madill, Oklahoma. [5]

Notes for WILLIAM JONATHAN SANDERS:

While it appears William and Avie married about 1898, Avie does appear in 1900 in her father's home. The census lists her as single. It is not known if she was visiting and this was a mistake of the census-taker, or if William & Avie married later. This would make their son Walter probably the son of William and an unknown woman. [CAR]

In 1900 Will Sanders with wife Annie and son Walter are living in Collin County, Texas. Will's age and birthplace are not correct, however everything else looked like him. Will Sanders, age 20, born in Texas, parents born in Georgia and Tennessee, a farmer. Wife Annie, also 20, born in Texas, father born in Virginia, mother's birthplace unclear. They have been married 2 years and have 1 child. Their son Walter was born Nov 1899 and is one year old. Also in the house was a lodger Dora Spergeon and her child Elis.

William and Avie moved to Oklahoma between 1906 and 1909.

In the 1910 Census, William Sanders is living in Odell township, Marshall Co, Oklahoma. He is 33 and a farmer. William was born in Tennessee, his father in South Carolina, and his mother in Tennessee. Living with him is his wife Avie, 30. Avie was born in Virginia, her father in Tennessee, and her mother in West Virginia. William and Avie have been married 12 years, and Avie has had 5 children, 4 are living. With them are their children Walter M, 11, born in Texas, Aldie G, 6, Texas, Lester R, 4, Texas, and Bertie W, 4 months, Oklahoma.

William returned to Texas in 1915, after his father's death in December 1914 [3] and wife Avie's death in Collin County on Jan 1, 1916.

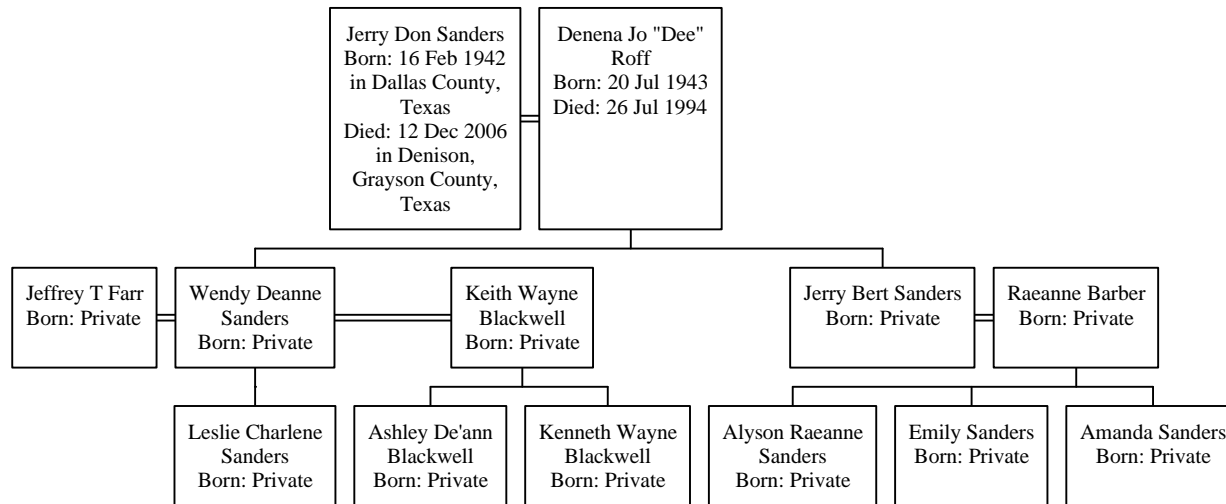

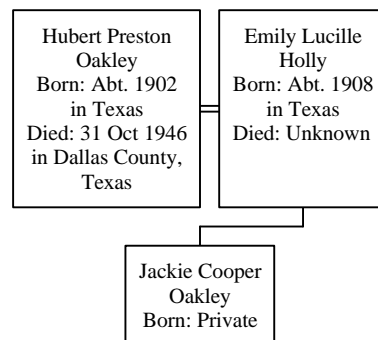

She then married Dan Brumbaugh, died soon after, again leaving her with a new baby. At the age of eight or nine, Annie went to live with Superintendent Edington's family at the Darke County Infirmary - which housed the elderly, the orphaned and the mentally ill. She remained with the Edington's until she was 13 or 14. When she returned to her family, Annie's mother had married a third time to Joseph Shaw.

Married - Frank E. Butler (1850-1926) marriage on August 23, 1876.

Annie Oakley died of pernicious anemia on Nov. 3, 1926, in Greenville, Ohio, at the age sixty-six.
