Descendants of George Evans

1-**George Evans**¹ was born in 1702² and died in 1754² at age 52.

George married **Elizabeth Kendall**.¹ They had one son: **James**.

2-**James Evans**¹ was born on 6 August 1748³ and died on 16 January 1823⁴ at age 74.

General Notes: Married Mary Brooke, his first cousin's daughter, on Jan. 16, 1771, in St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Philadelphia. Mary Brooke is dgtr. of Mary Evans, b.1724, and James Brooke, who was great-grandson of John & Frances Brooke, emigrants in 1698. --Lives of the Eminent Dead...Norristown, Pa. 1879. Father was George Evans (1702-1754); Mother was Elizabeth Kendall. [Elaine Jeter]

He fought in the American Revolution. (DAR records) [Elaine Jeter]

The tax assessment for Limerick Twp for 1776 says he is a "joiner", and owns 170A of land. 1 horse, and 2 cows. [Elaine Jeter]

James married **Mary Brooke**,¹ daughter of **James Brooke** and **Mary Evans**, on 16 January 1771 in St Pauls Episcopal Church, Philadelphia, PA.² Mary was born on 30 September 1749³ and died on 25 October 1828⁴ at age 79. They had two children: **Samuel** and **James**.

Noted events in her life were:

- Alt. Birth: 1748.²
- Alt. Death: 1823.²

3-**Samuel Evans**⁵ was born on 11 October 1771 and died on 10 July 1825⁵ at age 53.

General Notes: Samuel Evans is implied as a son of James Evans and Mary (Brooke) Evans. His death on 10 July 1825 at age 53 yrs. 8 mo. 29 das. is part of an apparent bible transcription. [1]

3-**James Evans Jr**⁶ was born on 9 March 1773 in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania⁷ and died on 3 April 1842⁸ at age 69.

General Notes: James Evans Jr. enlisted in the Pennsylvania militia 9/6/1814; discharged 1/4/1815. Ref: Pennsylvania Archives, v.7, p.471 [Elaine Jeter]

James Evans, Jr., was a Lieutenant-Colonel in the Pennsylvania Militia, and a member of the Pennsylvania Legislature. [Old Phila Families, The North American, Phila, 1912]

James married **Charlotte Brooke**,⁶ daughter of **John Brooke** and **Elizabeth May**, on 24 December 1796.⁶ Charlotte was born on 30 July 1776⁸ and died on 4 April 1841⁸ at age 64. They had eight children: **Anna**, **Thomas**, **Josiah W**, **Elizabeth**, **Owen Brooke**, **Harriett**, **Charlotte**, and **James B**.

Noted events in their marriage were:

4-**Anna Evans**⁶ was born on 15 July 1798 in Pennsylvania,⁸ died on 27 June

1871 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania⁰ at age 72, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹¹

General Notes: Anna may have been of Welsh descent.

In the 1860 Census, Ann Barlow and her daughter Charlotte are living with Ann's son Mahlon and his family in Limerick township. Ann is 62, and owns personal property worth \$600. Also in the house are Ann's daughter Mary and her husband John Kugler.

In the 1870 Census, Anna is living in Limerick Township, Montgomery Co, PA, in the house of her son James Barlow and his wife Sophia. She is 73 years old. Also living with them is her daughter Charlotte, 35.

Anna married **John Barlow**,⁶ son of **John Barlow** and **Phoebe Bolton**, on 7 January 1820.⁴ John was born on 12 August 1790 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁰ died on 23 April 1847 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹² at age 56, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹³ They had seven children: **James, Mahlon, Mary Evans, Evan, Mark, Charlotte, and John.**

5-**James Barlow**¹⁵ was born on 7 October 1820 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁶ died on 25 January 1881 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹⁷ at age 60, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹¹

General Notes: In the 1860 Census, James was a farmer [Elaine Jeter]

In the 1870 Census, James is living in Limerick Township, Montgomery Co, PA. He is 50 years old and a farmer. The value of his real estate is \$500 and his personal estate \$1200. James' wife Sophia, 44, is listed as the head of household, although the census taker placed the household number on the line above. Living with them are their children Elizabeth, 19, Richard, 17, Calvin, 15, Andrew, 12, and Brooke, 9. Also in the house are James' mother Anna, 73, and his sister Charlotte, 35.

James married **Sophia Markley**,¹⁵ daughter of **Andrew Markley** and **Elizabeth Stetler**, on 20 February 1848.¹⁸ Sophia was born on 30 September 1822 in Pennsylvania,¹⁹ died on 24 December 1903 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania²⁰ at age 81, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹¹ They had six children:

6-Elizabeth Ann Barlow¹⁸ was born on 12 June 1850 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁸ died on 11 March 1922 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹⁸ at age 71, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹⁸ Another name for Elizabeth was Elizabeth Barlow.¹⁵

General Notes: Listed on Census of 1860, 1870, 1880 in Limerick Township. [Elaine Jeter]

Noted events in her life were:

- Alt. Birth: Abt 1853.¹⁵

Elizabeth married **Warren S Kugler**,¹⁸ son of **John Kugler** and **Elizabeth Server**, on 31 March 1885 in Trappe, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ Warren was born on 13 March 1849 in Pennsylvania,²¹ died on 16 April 1927 in Pottstown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania²¹ at age 78, and was buried on 20 April 1927 in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.²² Other names for Warren were Warren Kugler and Warren Kuyler.¹⁵

6-Richard Markley Barlow¹⁸ was born on 3 April 1852 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁸ died on 9 November 1926 in Pottstown Hospital, Pottstown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹⁸ at age 74, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.²⁴ Another name for Richard was Richard Barlow.¹⁵

General Notes: Listed on Census of 1860, 1870, 1880 in Limerick Township. [Elaine Jeter]

Buried with Richard and wife Elizabeth N, is Mary H Barlow, 1844-1920, possibly Richard's 2nd wife. They all share the same marker. [1]

Richard married **Elizabeth Neiman**,¹⁵ daughter of **Henry Neiman** and **Lydia Lachman**, on 29 March 1884 in Trappe, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ Elizabeth was born on 21 December 1851 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,²⁵ died on 5 October 1886 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania²⁵ at age 34, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.²⁴

Richard next married **Mary Hill Cochran**,¹⁸ daughter of **William Cochran** and **Frances Jane McAllister**, on 23 April 1898 in Pottstown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ Mary was born on 15 February 1844 in Brooklyn, New York,¹⁸ died in 1920²⁶ at age 76, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.²⁶ Another name for Mary was Mary H Cochran.¹⁵

6-James Calvin Barlow¹⁸ was born on 9 January 1854 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁷ died on 21 November 1931 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania²⁷ at age 77, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹¹ Another name for James was J Calvin Barlow.¹⁵

General Notes: Listed on Census of 1870, 1880 in Limerick Township. In 1880 he was listed as a teacher. [Elaine Jeter]

Calvin was educated at the common schools and at Washington Hall at Trappe, and followed teaching for ten years in Limerick township, after which he worked in the city of Philadelphia in the Kline & Company, stove foundry, for three years was clerk for the Marsh & Brownback Stove Company at Linfield, and during the year 1903 for the Royersford Trust Company.

He is a Free Mason, and a Knight of the Golden Eagle. He is a Democrat in politics, and during President Cleveland's administration was appointed postmaster of Linfield; he also served for nine years as assessor of Limerick township. His church membership is with the Lutheran church of Limerick township. For the past fourteen years he has made his home with his brother, Andrew M.

6-Andrew Markley Barlow¹⁸ was born on 16 October 1858 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁷ died on 18 June 1908 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania²⁸ at age 49, and was buried on 23 June 1908 in Royersford, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. The cause of his death was brain tumor. Another name for Andrew was Andrew M Barlow.¹⁵

General Notes: In the 1880 Census, Andrew is a telegraph operator and living with his parents. [Elaine Jeter]

Andrew was educated in the public schools and at Washington Hall at Trappe. He then resided in the home of an uncle with whom he learned the blacksmith trade. On completing his apprenticeship he went to Stempton, where he entered the car shops and worked at his trade, remaining there one year, after which he returned to his old home in Limerick township. He then learned telegraphy, and in 1879 entered the employ of the Philadelphia & Reading Railroad Company, remaining until 1890, when he removed to his present farm, which he purchased in 1886. Mr. Barlow is a Democrat, and served as school director for five terms. He is a member of the Masonic order; a Knight of the Golden Eagle; and a member of Humane Fire Company, No. 1, of Royersford.

Andrew married **Ida Matilda Yeager**,¹⁸ daughter of **William Schlichter Yeager** and **Harriett Matilda Place**, on 3 December 1881 in Trappe, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.¹⁷ Ida was born on 7 July 1859 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁸ died on 15 September 1909 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹⁸ at age 50, and was buried in St Vincent Cemetery, East Vincent twp, Chester County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ Another name for Ida was Ida M Yeager.¹⁵ They had three children: **Florence Sophia**, **William Yeager**, and **Bessie**.

6-Brooke Markley Barlow¹⁸ was born on 31 January 1862 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹⁸ died on 30 July 1933 in Pottstown Hospital, Pottstown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹⁸ at age 71, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹⁸ Another name for Brooke was Brooke M Barlow.¹⁵

General Notes: In the 1880 Census, Brooke is 17 and a farm laborer. [Elaine Jeter]

Brooke lives in Limerick Square, is assessor of the township, and a director in the Royersford Trust Company; he married Savilla Walt.

Brooke married **Sevilla Jane Walt**,¹⁸ daughter of **Henry C Walt** and **Annie Krause**, on 27 December 1890 in Prescott, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ Sevilla was born on 10 March 1864 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹⁸ and died in August 1928 in Pottstown Hospital, Pottstown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania¹⁸ at age 64. Another name for Sevilla was Savilla Walt.¹⁵

Brooke next married **Louisa E Rambo**,¹⁸ daughter of **Samuel A Rambo** and **Elisabeth Schrack**, on 27 December 1930 in Trappe,

Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ Louisa was born on 23 April 1873 in Upper Providence Twp, Montgomery Co, Pennsylvania.¹⁸

General Notes: Louisa was previously married to a man named Price. [1]

5-**Mahlon Barlow**⁶ was born on 10 November 1822 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,³⁰ died on 20 August 1863 in Pennsylvania³¹ at age 40, and was buried in St James Churchyard (Limerick Churchyard), Limerick, PA.¹³

General Notes: In the 1860 Census, Mahlon Barlow is living in Limerick township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. He is 37, a farmer, and has a personal estate of \$250. Living with him are his wife Hannah, 31, children John, 11, Lydia A, 9, Owen, 7, Abraham, 5, Elizabeth B, 3, Anna, 1, mother Ann, 62, sister Charlotte, 25, John Kugler, 34, and wife Mary Kugler, 21, the Kugler's daughter Hannah, 1, and Franklin Kugler, 20.

"I do not know whether my grandpa had gone on an errand or to work, but on Aug. 20, 1863 when he did not return home, neighbors went in search of him. Evidently he fell ill & sat down under a tree to rest - there neighbors found his body.

On his tombstone is this inscription: "Mahlon Barlow lived in matrimony with Hannah Hallman 15 years and died Aug 20, 1863. Age 40 years, 9 months, 10 days" [1]

Mahlon married **Hannah Hallman**,⁶ daughter of **Abraham Hallman** and **Elisabeth Trumbauer**, on 1 June 1848.⁶ Hannah was born on 2 August 1828 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,³² died on 8 September 1903 in Phoenixville, Chester County, Pennsylvania³³ at age 75, and was buried in Morris Cemetery, Phoenixville, Chester County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ The cause of her death was Apoplexy. They had eight children: **John Franklin**, **Lydia Ann**, **Owen Evans**, **Abraham**, **Elizabeth Bertha "Lizzie,"** **Anna Ruberta**, **Mahlon H**, and **Alfred (Albert) Hallman**.

General Notes: Cousin Elaine Jeter placed Hannah with these parents and siblings based on a Bible in possession of Craig and Karen Eiding (craige@ptd.net). Elaine dated her note 4/5/1999. It is not known where Lotta Reuther Longstreet obtained her information on Hannah's parents.

Hanna was widowed at age 35 with 8 children ranging in age from one month to 14 years [2].

In the 1870 Census, Hannah is living in Limerick Township, Montgomery Co, PA. She is 43 years old and living in the house of Catherine Miller, 62 (b. abt 1806), along with Joseph Miller, 28 (b. abt 1842), and Mary Miller, 63 (b. abt 1807). Living with Hannah is her son Alfred, age 6. Living next door is her son John and his wife Mary. Also nearby (same census page) are Hannah's brother Alfred Hallman, her late husband Mahlon's brother James and their mother Anna Barlow.

In the 1880 Census, Hannah is apparently the Hannah Hallman, 51 & widowed, in Limerick Township in the house of Joseph Miller, 38, the same household she was living at in 1870. Also in the house are Mary Miller, 83, Harriet Davis, 67, and Harriet's son Frank, 29, with Frank's wife Susie and their daughter Anne. Hannah is a housekeeper along with Harriet Davis.

In the 1900 Census, Hannah Barlow is living in Phoenixville, Chester Co, Pennsylvania. She is 71 years old (born Aug 1829) and widowed. Hannah has had 8 children and 6 are living. She is a housekeeper in the house of Joseph Miller, 58, a carpenter.
(Owen and Elizabeth died in 1894 & 1890, respectively.)

At this time, we do not have any information on who the Millers were that Hannah lived with after she was widowed, and whether they are related.

Hannah's great-granddaughter Mary Elizabeth Barlow thought her grandfather John Franklin Barlow's emigration to Iowa was at least partly because his wife (Mary Clemens) was unable to get along with his mother (Hannah Hallman Barlow.) She may be right, and perhaps John Franklin was not the only family member who had that problem... ??? [EJ]

Hannah Barlow, Hannah, age 75, widow, born in Montgomery County, died 1903/09/08 in Phoenixville of appoplexy. [1]

6-John Franklin Barlow³⁴ was born on 1 May 1849 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,³⁵ died on 19 March 1910 in Dunkerton, Black Hawk County, Iowa³⁶ at age 60, and was buried on 22 March 1910 in Fairview Cemetery, Dunkerton, Black Hawk County, Iowa.³⁷

General Notes: After his father's death when he was just 14 year old, John went to work, probably learning the carpentry trade that he used later in life.

In the 1870 Census, John is living in Limerick Township, Montgomery Co, PA. John is 21 years old and a carpenter. Living with him is his wife Mary.

Next door is his mother Hannah and youngest brother Alfred.

John moved to Dunkerton, Iowa, about 1877. He was a carpenter by trade. Although the family owned farmland, and were probably also farmers, they lived in a house in Dunkerton from before 1900. The house was sold when John died. [2]

In the 1880 Census (familysearch.org), John and his wife Mary, are living in Black Hawk, Iowa with their children George, age 9, Addie, age 7, and Jacob, age 3.

In 1900, John Barlow is living in Lester township, Black Hawk County, Iowa. He is 51, born May 1849 in Pennsylvania, and is a carpenter. Living with him are his wife Mary M, 48, born Dec 1851 in Pennsylvania, and their sons Frank C, 17, born Apr 1882, and John M, 11, born July 1888. Mary is incorrectly listed as having born 2 children, both living.

John married **Mary Malisa Clemens**,¹³ daughter of **Jacob Clemens** and **Margaret Ralston**, on 4 June 1870 in Freeland, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania.¹³ Mary was born on 31 December 1851 in Spring City, Chester County, Pennsylvania,¹³ died on 5 January 1940 in Waterloo, Black Hawk County, Iowa¹³ at age 88, and was buried in Dunkerton, Black Hawk County, Iowa.¹³ They had five children: **George Ralston**, **Addie E**, **Jacob**, **Chester Franklin "Frank"**, and **John Mahlon**.

Marriage Notes: June 18, 1870, local newspaper clipping: BARLOW-CLEMENS - At Freeland, on June 4th, by Rev. J. H. Hendricks, Mr. John F. Barlow, of Limerick, Montgomery county, to Miss Mary M. Clemens, of East Pikeland. [Elaine Jeter]

General Notes: Mary refused to "accept" her son Frank's wife Susan Duffy because she was Catholic and Mary was Baptist. Mary "never spoke" to Susan. [1]

After the death of her husband John in 1910, Mary sold the large family home in Dunkerton, Iowa, and bought a house in Waterloo, Iowa, where she lived with her son John until his marriage. After John married, Mary built a small house next door and lived there the rest of her life. [Elaine Jeter]

6-**Lydia Ann Barlow**¹³ was born on 3 October 1850 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹³ died on 2 November 1945 in Phoenixville, Chester County, Pennsylvania³⁹ at age 95, and was buried

on 5 November 1945 in Phoenixville, Chester County, Pennsylvania.³⁹
Another name for Lydia was Lydia A Barlow.⁴⁰

General Notes: Lydia Ann Barlow was born Oct 3 1850, baptised Dec 15 1850, parents Mahlon & Hannah Barlow, per baptismal record of St James Reformed Church. [Elaine Jeter]

At her father's death, Lydia had not yet reached her 13th birthday. She went to live with a relative. She was miserably treated as a servant. She was given so little to eat that she would nibble on chicken bones & chop bones that were left on plates in order to get a few extra bites. Some days she was so hungry she would shave off the thinnest slice of bread possible, but it was generally detected & she was punished. She did not complain to her mother, but it was discovered by a friend & reported to her mother. Of course her mother brought her home. [1]

In the 1870 Census, Lydia Barlow 19 years old and living as a domestic servant in the home of her mother's sister Elizabeth Hallman Springer and her husband Hiram Springer in Phoenixville, Chester Co, Pennsylvania. The Springers were very wealthy - Hiram listed his real estate value at \$75,000 and his personal property at \$2000. Elizabeth (Hallman) Springer had a separate business, a store that sold "trimmings".

In 1930, Lydia (Barlow) Keeley gave her grand-niece Mary Elizabeth Barlow Spunaugle a small handtowel with hand-work (lace and embroidery). Mary's daughter Elaine has that towel and considers it an heirloom, and with the "starvation" and knowing where Lydia was living in 1870, it is even more precious. [Elaine Jeter]

In the 1930 Census, Lydia A Keely is living in Phoenixville, Chester Co, PA, at 2 Anderson Avenue in the house of her son-in-law Paul Martens. She is 79 years old and a widow.

In 1940 Lydia Keely is living in Phoenixville with daughter Anna Martens and her family. Lydia is 90 years old, and does have income. [3]

In the 1900 Census, Harry W Keeley is living in Phoenixville, Chester Co, PA, at 159 1st Avenue. Harry is 49 years old and a telegraph operator. Living with him are his wife Lydia A, 49, son Fred J, 18, and daughter Annie E, 7. Harry and Lydia have been married 26 years, and Lydia has had four children, three are living.

In the 1910 Census, Harry W Keely is living in Phoenixville at 139 First Avenue. He is 59 years old and an operator on the railroad. Living with him are his wife Lydia A, 59. They have been married 37 years. Lydia has had four children, three are living. Living with them are their daughter Anna E, 17, and son Fred J, 28. Also in the house is a boarder, Sarah E Flick [or Fleck], 20, and a dressmaker.

In the 1920 Census, Harry W Keely is living in Phoenixville. He is 65 years old (should be 69), and appears to be retired (his occupation is none). Living with him is his wife Lidia, 66. They are renters in the house of Augusta Emery and his wife Blanche, 29 & 24 years old, at 135 First Ave.

Living with her are her children Hannah, 30, Sue, 28, Ida, 25, Charlotte, 22, John 16, and Catherine Gage, 26, as well as Catherine's husband Luther Gage, 31, and their son Barlow Gage, 2. Also living with them is Florence St. John, a boarder.

In the 1920 Census, Lydia is living in Philadelphia at 615 44th Street. She is 63 years old and widowed. Living with her are her daughters Hannah

Abraham's brother & sister Mahlon & Anna were living with the parents of Henry Fetterolf's wife Elizabeth Garber. (Elaine Jeter research on the Garbers)

Elizabeth (Garber) Fetterolf is likely a relative of Abraham's aunt Mary (Barlow) Miller whose mother-in-law was a Garber.

Abraham married Amanda Rosenberger in 1876.

They were in Black Hawk County, Iowa, in 1877 when daughter Sarah was born. [2] Brother John and his family were in Black Hawk.

In the 1900 Census, Abram H Barlow is living in Phoenixville, Chester Co, Pennsylvania. He is 45 years old and a carpenter. Living with him are his wife Amanda, 41, son Horace K, 9, and grandson Augustus, 2. Abram and Amanda have been married 24 years [since abt 1876], and Amanda has had 4 children, all are living.

In the 1910 Census, Abraham is living in Phoenixville. He is 54 years old (born about 1856), and a house carpenter. Living with him are his wife Amanda, 51, and son Horace, 19. Horace is a salesman. Abraham and Amanda have been married 34 years. Amanda has had 5 children, 4 are still living. [1] Abraham's sister Lydia and her husband Harry Keely also live in Phoenixville.

In the 1920 Census, Abram Barlow is living at 316 Washington Ave in Phoenixville. He is 64 years old, and a house carpenter. Living with him is his wife Amanda, 61, their son Horace K, 28, and Horace's wife Helen, 24. Horace is also a house carpenter, and Helen is an operator at a knitting mill.

In 1880 Sylvester Boyer is living in Pottsgrove with his parents. Sylvester is 23 and a farm laborer. Parents Phillip R Boyer and Maria are 62 and 45, respectively. Phillip is a farmer. Also with them are Fiana Reubert, 20, servant, Samuel Levensgood, 80, boarder & retired farmer, and Jeremiah Kalb, 52, farmer. [3]

In the 1888-1893 city directories, Sylvester L Boyer is living in Pottstown at 337 Walnut. He is a laborer. [4] This is the same address his mother and children are at in 1900.

6-**Anna Ruberta Barlow**⁶⁶ was born on 22 November 1858 in Limerick Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,⁶⁷ died on 10 March 1930 in Daytona Beach, Volusia County, Florida⁶⁸ at age 71, and was buried on 14 March 1930 in Westminster Cemetary, Bala Cynwyd, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.⁶⁹ The cause of her death was pneumonia & influenza.

General Notes: When her father died, "my mother was not quite 5 years old & remained at home with her mother & later attended the little country school. There was no compulsory education law in those years and after finishing the 4th grade she went to work.

"I am ashamed to confess that I do not know what she did or when she went to Phila. Nor do I know how or when she started in the pleating business. I do know that she owned the first knife pleating machine in Phila." [6]

Anna would have been about 9 years old when she left home and went to work.

In 1870 Anna and her brother Mahlon appear to be living in Upper Providence township, Montgomery Co, Pennsylvania, in the house of Charles Garber. Anna is 11, and Mahlon is 9. Mahlon has attended school during the year, but Anna has not. Both children are listed on the census as Barber instead of Barlow.

Charles Garber is likely a relative of Anna's aunt Mary (Barlow) Miller whose mother-in-law was a Garber.

Mahlon & Anna's brother Abraham Barlow was living with Charles & Harriet Garber's daughter Elizabeth Garber Fetterolf and her family. Charles Garber's daughter Anna married a man named Vanderslice. (Elaine Jeter's research on the Garbers.) Anna Barlow's first husband was John Vanderslice.

Early in 1880 Annie Barlow is living in a rooming house in Philadelphia operated by her uncle Abe Hallman. Annie is a seamstress. Also in the house is her future first husband John Vanderslice.

Anna was married first to a promising young Philadelphia lawyer, John R. Vanderslice. Their first year of marriage was drawing to a close when their

baby Charles Edgar was born 3/25/1881. While she was confined with the birth of their son, her husband was stricken with pneumonia & died. Soon after that the baby died. So she was a bride, a mother, a widow and childless within 12 months. [2]

John Vanderslice appears to be the John P Vanderslice, lawyer, who died of Typhoid Fever on 22 April 1881.

In 1915 A R Reuther advertised her Knife & Accordion Pleating business. She pleated kilted, box and sun ray skirts. Mail orders received prompt attention. Her business was at 252 N. 8th street. [4]

Anna fell ill while visiting daughter Lotta in Daytona Beach, Florida. She and Henry had arrived about 17 February (21 days before her death). Anna died on 10 March 1930 of pneumonia and influenza. She had been attended by the doctor since 4 March. After she became so ill, her son Russell rushed from Connecticut to see her, but she died before he got there. [1, 3, 4]

John P Vanderslice, died 22 April 1881 at age 29 years, 2 months & 19 days, is buried at Morris Cemetery in Phoenixville. [2]

Anna next married **Henry Christian Reuther**,⁷⁴ son of **Christian John Reuther** and **Emilie Klobe**, on 25 July 1888 in Phoenixville, Chester County, Pennsylvania.⁷⁵ Henry was born on 17 March 1859 in Green Township, Clinton County, Pennsylvania,⁷⁶ was christened on 17 April 1865 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania,⁷⁷ died on 5 June 1932 in Fairfield, Fairfield County, Connecticut⁷⁴ at age 73, and was buried on 8 June 1932 in Westminster Cemetary, Bala Cynwyd, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.⁷⁸ Another name for Henry was Christian Heinrich Reuther.⁷⁷ They had four children: **Edna Laura**, **Lotta Barlow**, **Russell Evans**, and **Florence Anna**.

Marriage Notes: The marriage took place at Anna's sister Lydia's home in Phoenixville, Pennsylvania [1].

Henry and Anna owned a store in Philadelphia. On the first floor Henry sold cutlery such as knives and scissors. He also sold other goods such as china and leather goods. The family still has knives, scissors, and tea cups that came from the store. On the second floor, Anna operated a pleating business.

Per a letter from Florence Reuther Becker to Lydia Speiser Reuther on June 18, 1968, the store was located on 8th Street. It must have been within a few blocks of 8th and Arch Streets, as this was the location of a store called George B. Evans that sold fancy candies, cakes, and fruits. The store also sold gifts and fine china. It covered the entire block on the 8th Street side. Anna passed this store on her way to Henry's store. It was at Evans that she saw a beautiful punch bowl in the window, that Henry subsequently

surprised her with for Valentine's Day, reportedly in their first or second year of marriage, probably about 1889. The punch bowl set is currently owned by Catherine Reuther. The green bowl and top is decorated with strawberries, with matching cups, and a platter with strawberry flowers and leaves to sit on. [2]

Henry and Anna's store was located at 250 - 252 8th Street in Philadelphia. [3]

In the 1890 , Henry is living at 510 Franklin Street. He is a bookkeeper. [6]
In 1895 & 1896, Henry C Reuther is still on Franklin street, but he is now a stationer ar 252 N 8th st. [5]

In 1896 Henry C Reuther is selling "fancy goods" at 252 N 8th. He is living at 510 Franklin. In 1898 he is selling toys at 252 E 8th, and is now living at 635 N 12th. [2]

In the 1900 Census, Henry Reuther (Ruther on the census) is living at 635 North Twelfth Street in Philadelphia. He is 40 years old and a stationary dealer. Living with him is his wife Anna, 40. They have been married 12 years. Living with them are their children Edna, 11, Lotta, 8, Russell, 7, and Florence, 2, Anna's aunt Charlotte Barlow, 70, and Anna's nephew Frank Keely (Keighly on the census), 25. In addition, there are 4 boarders and 2 servants in the house.

On 26 October 1901, Henry C & Anna R Reuther sold their home at 635 N Twelth St to Wm J Ferguson for \$4000. But in 1902 a permit was issued to Ambrose Beck to add a 4.6 x 10 ft addition for \$600 to the home of H C Reuther at 635 N 12th st. [2, 3]

Henry's obituary in the paper reads "Mr. Henry C. Reuther, for many years a resident of Logan, at 4713 North Twelfth street, passed away at the home of his son in Bridgeport, Connecticut, and was buried from the undertaker parlors of Mr Keller, and old friend, on Wednesday afternoon. He was a member of Muhlenberg Lutheran Church, whose pastor conducted the funeral."
