Descendants of John Fleetwood

1-John Fleetwood

John married **Anne Boyd**. They had one son: **Green**.

2-**Green Fleetwood**,¹ son of **John Fleetwood**² and **Anne Boyd**², was born on 16 Jan 1810 in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia,² died on 3 Nov 1856 in Whitemarsh Island, Georgia² at age 46, and was buried in Laurel Grove Cemetery, Savannah, Georgia.³

General Notes: In the 1850 Census, Green Fleetwood is living in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia. He is 59 (or maybe 39) years old and a pilot. He was born in Georgia. The value of his real estate is \$3000. Living with Green are Mary, 39, Thomas M, 15, also a pilot, James M, 13, William H, 10, Mary, 6, and Laura C, 3. Everyone was born in Georgia.

Green died November 3, 1856, at his plantation on Whitemarsh Island near Savannah. [1]

Green married **Mary Morgan**,³ daughter of **Thomas Morgan**³ and **Lucretia Crawford**,³ on 10 Dec 1832 in Effingham County, Georgia.⁴ Mary was born on 5 Oct 1810 in Effingham County, Georgia,³ died on 29 Nov 1878 in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia³ at age 68, and was buried on 30 Nov 1878 in Laurel Grove Cemetery, Savannah, Georgia.⁵ Another name for Mary was Mary.¹ They had seven children: **Thomas Madison, James Monroe, William Henry, Mary Lucretia, Laura C, John Wesley, and George S**.

Noted events in their marriage were:

- Alt. Marriage: 9 Dec 1832, Effingham County, Georgia.⁶
- Alt. Marriage: Bef 1835.

General Notes: According to "The Fleetwoods and Related Families of Savannah - Chatham County, Georgia" typewritten manuscript, Mary was born in Effingham County, Georgia. On the 1860 Census, her birthplace is specifically identified as Savannah. (Usually the census taker listed only the state in the birthplace column.)

In the 1860 Census, Mary Fleetwood is living in Savannah, Georgia. She is 45 years old, and her occupation is "Lady of Leisure". The value of her real estate is \$5000, and her personal estate is \$2000. Mary owns 7 slaves between the ages of 25 and 2. The Slave Schedule did not show a slave house, so they must have been living in the family residence.

Living with Mary are her children Thomas, 25, James, 23, Henry (William H), 20, Mary S, 16, Laura C, 14, John W, 8, and George S, 6. Thomas, James, and Henry are pilots and own some personal property. Everyone was born in Savannah, Georgia.

In the 1870 Census, Mary is living in the house headed by her son Thomas in Savannah. She is 59 years old, born in Georgia, and is keeping house. Also in the house are her sons James & William, Thomas's wife Laura, William's wife Catherine, and William's two

children.

Noted events in her life were:

- Alt. Birth: Abt 1811, Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia.⁷
- Alt. Death: Between 1870 and 1880.
- Alt. Death: 28 Nov 1878.⁵

3-**Thomas Madison Fleetwood**⁸ was born on 25 Feb 1834 in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia,⁹ died on 14 Jun 1896¹⁰ at age 62, and was buried on 15 Jun 1896 in Laurel Grove Cemetery, Savannah, Georgia.¹⁰ Another name for Thomas was Thomas M Fleetwood.¹

General Notes: In the 1850 Census, Thomas is 15 years old and a pilot like his father. He is still living at home.

In the 1860 Census, Thomas is living with his mother and siblings in Savannah. He is 25 years old and a pilot as are his brothers James and Henry (William H). Thomas owns real estate valued at \$1000 and personal property of \$800.

In the 1870 Census, Thomas is living in Savannah. He is 35 years old and a pilot. Thomas owns real estate valued at \$4000 and personal property of \$300. Living in the house are his wife Laura, 22, brothers James and Wm H, mother Mary, William's wife Catherine, William's 2 sons, and Anna Marshall, 14, a servant.

In the 1880 Census, Thomas is living in Savannah at #38 Habersham Street, next door to his brother James. Thomas is 45 years old and a steam ship captain. Living with him are his wife Laura, 35, sons Maderson, 7, and Laurence, 3, and brother George.

In 1888-1891, Thomas M. Fleetwood was living in Savannah at 38 Habersham. He was a pilot. - Savannah, Georgia Directories, 1888-91 (Ancestry.com)

Noted events in his life were:

- Alt. Birth: Abt 1835, Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia.⁷

Thomas married **Laura Howell White**⁸ before Jul 1870.¹¹ Laura was born in Nov 1845,⁸ died on 23 Oct 1928⁵ at age 82, and was buried in Laurel Grove Cemetery, Savannah, Georgia.⁵ Another name for Laura was Laura H.¹² They had two children: **Thomas Madison** and **Laurence White**.

Marriage Notes: The Thomas W. Fleetwood, 1871-May 15, 1872, buried in Laurel Grove Cemetery is probably the son of Thomas and Laura Fleetwood, who are buried nearby. He died at age 1 year, 3 months, 17 days, and was buried on May 19. [1]

General Notes: In the 1900 Census, Laura H Fleetwood is living at 10 Duffy Street West in Savannah. She is 45 years old (should be about 55), and widowed. She has had 2 children and both are living. Living with her is her son Lawrence, 22. Lawrence is a pilot.

- Alt. Birth: 1845.⁵
- Alt. Birth: Abt 1848, Georgia.¹¹

4-**Thomas Madison Fleetwood Jr**⁸ was born on 31 Oct 1872 in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia,¹³ died on 20 Jul 1946 in Saint Johns County, Florida¹⁴ at age 73, and was buried in Laurel Grove Cemetery, Savannah, Georgia.⁸ Other names for Thomas were M Thomas Fleetwood¹⁵ and Maderson Fleetwood.¹⁶

General Notes: In the 1900 Census, M Thomas Fleetwood is living at 32 Habersham Street in Savannah, Georgia. He is 28 years old, born in Georgia, and a bookkeeper. Living with him are his wife Birdie, 28, and daughter Lena, 1. Birdie was born in South Carolina and her parents in Germany.

Noted events in his life were:

- Alt. Birth: Oct 1872, Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia.¹⁵
- Alt. Birth: Abt 1873, Georgia.¹⁶

Thomas married **Birdie**¹⁵ about 1898.¹⁵ Birdie was born in Jan 1872 in South Carolina.¹⁵ They had one daughter: **Lena**.

4-**Laurence White Fleetwood**⁸ was born on 23 Oct 1877 in Brooklyn (Kings County), New York,⁸ died on 24 Nov 1924 in Chatham County, Georgia¹⁷ at age 47, and was buried in Bonaventure Cemetery, Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia.⁸ Other names for Laurence were Laurence Fleetwood¹⁶ and Lawrence Fleetwood.¹⁵

General Notes: Lawrence is probably the Lawrence W. Fleetwood who died 24 Nov 1924 in Chathan County, Georgia. [Georgia Deaths 1919-98 (Ancestry.com)]

Noted events in his life were:

- Alt. Birth: Abt 1877, Georgia.¹⁶
- Alt. Birth: Oct 1877, Georgia.¹⁵
- Occupation: Pilot, 1900.¹⁵

3-**James Monroe Fleetwood**¹⁸ was born on 29 Sep 1836 in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia,¹⁹ died on 25 Feb 1885 in Talladega, Talladega County, Alabama²⁰ at age 48, and was buried in Oak Hill Cemetery, Talladega, Alabama.²¹

General Notes: In the 1860 Census, James is living with his mother and siblings in Savannah. He is 23 years old and a pilot as are his brothers Thomas and Henry (William H). James' personal property is valued at \$500.

In May 1862, James enlisted as a private in Company G of the 1st Georgia Infantry. On May 23, 1863, James was assigned to the Atlanta warship in Savannah. On June 17, 1863, James was the pilot of the Atlanta when it left the Wilmington River to engage the Federal blockade ships Weehawkin and Nahant. The Atlanta ran aground and was captured. James was imprisoned in Ft. Hancock in Boston Harbor until October 1864 when he was paroled and made his way home to Savannah. [2]

In the 1870 Census, James is living in Savannah in the house of his brother Thomas. He is 32 years old, and a pilot. He owns real estate valued at \$2500.

According to Blanche Fleetwood, James and his family lived part of the time in Talladega, Alabama, and part in Savannah, Georgia. Some of their children were born

in Talladega, and some in Savannah. [1]

In the 1870's James was captain of a pilot boat in Savannah harbor. In 1880, he became captain of the City of Savannah, owned by the Ocean Steamship Company. The City of Savannah sailed between Savannah and New York. [2]

In the 1880 Census, James is a living at #40 Habersham Street in Savannah, Georgia. He is 45 years old, and a pilot. Living with him are his wife Emelia [Cornelia], 30, and their sons James M, 8, born in Alabama, Harry B, 6, born in Georgia, Julian A, 2, born in Alabama. Emelia was born in Alabama and her parents were born in Tennessee. Living next door is James' brother Thomas and his family, as well as their brother George.

In 1882, James had a serious accident while in charge of the Schooner Susan B. Day. Apparently after this accident, he and his family moved to Talladega, Alabama, where he died in 1886 at age 49. [2]

According to his obituary, James had been suffering for several months from paralysis before his death and had moved to Talladega 18 months earlier. [3]

James married **Philatia Metzger**¹⁹ on 3 Feb 1865 in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia.² Philatia died between 1865 and 1870. Another name for Philatia was Felicia B Metzger.²⁴

Marriage Notes: James Fleetwood married Felicia B Metzger on 1 Feb 1865 in Chatham County, Georgia. [1]

James and Philatia had no children.

James next married **Cornelia Thompson**,¹⁹ daughter of **George W Thompson**¹ and **Sarah Hood**,¹⁹ on 26 Oct 1870.¹⁹ Cornelia was born on 14 Oct 1849 in Talladega, Talladega County, Alabama,²⁵ died on 4 Nov 1934 in Talladega, Talladega County, Alabama²⁶ at age 85, and was buried on 5 Nov 1934 in Oak Hill Cemetery, Talladega, Alabama.²⁷ They had four children: **James Monroe**, **Harry Evans**, **Julian Faley**, and **Blanche Cooper**.

General Notes: After the death of James, Cornelia filed a pension application in Talladega for James' service in the Civil War.

In the 1910 Census, Cornelia Fleetwood is living at 208 South Street in Talladega, Talladega County, Alabama. She is 58 years old, born in Alabama, and her parents were born in Tennessee. Living with her are her son Julian, 31, born in Alabama, daughter Blanche, 26, born in Georgia, and sister Mary Thompson, 71, born in Alabama. Julian is a superintendent for the railroad.

In the 1920 Census, Cornelia Fleetwood is living at 208 South Street in Talladega. She is 67 years old, born in Alabama, and her parents were both born in Tennessee. Living with her are her daughter Blanche, 34, born in Georgia, and her sister Mary Thompson, 81, born in Alabama. None of the ladies are working.

In the 1930 Census, Cornelia Fleetwood is living at 208 South Street in Talladega. She is 81 years old, born in Alabama, and widowed. She married when she was 19 years old. Her father was born in Alabama and her mother in Tennessee. Living with Cornelia is her daughter Blanche, 42, born in Georgia.

Noted events in her life were:

- Alt. Birth: 1850, Alabama.¹⁶

4-James Monroe Fleetwood¹⁹ was born on 1 Oct 1871 in Talladega County, Alabama,²⁸ died in Jul 1899¹⁹ at age 27, and was buried in Talladega, Talladega County, Alabama.¹⁹ Another name for James was James M. Fleetwood.¹⁶

General Notes: James was a Pullman conductor on one of the trains operating out of Chicago. [1]

James never married.

- Alt. Birth: 1872.¹⁶

4-Harry Evans Fleetwood²⁹ was born on 21 Nov 1873 in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia,³⁰ died on 25 Aug 1922 in Mobile, Mobile County, Alabama³¹ at age 48, and was buried in Oak Hill Cemetery, Talladega, Alabama.²³ The cause of his death was suicide.³²

General Notes: Harry's father was a captain on a liner that ran between New York and Savannah. [3]

B & A Railroad - The railroad crossed the Coosa River at Stenley (between Cropwell & Talladega) on a wooden bridge, which at one time collapsed under a loaded train, and would have proved a horrible tragedy of the bravery and presence of mind of a colored porter Jordan Cranford (Dicie's husband) and the conductor Henry Fleetwood had not saved the lives of passengers. Jordan Cranford was lauded far and wide for having dived under the water and pulled out every passenger handing them to Mr. Fleetwood and his brother Julian, who stood on top of the car, which was not submerged. In 1906, Harry was working for the Lacey-Buek Iron Company in Birmingham, Alabama. [5]

In 1910, H E Fleetwood is living in Walker County, Alabama. He is 37 years old, born in Georgia, and a superintendent of the coal mines. Living with him is his wife Julia J, 37, son Harry Hill, 9, and daughter Sarah, 11 months. Henry and Julia have been married 12 years. Julia has had two children, both are living.

In September 1918, Harry Evans Fleetwood registered for the World War I draft. He was 44 years old, born November 24 1873. Harry was living at Burnwell Mines, Walker County, Alabama, and was in coal mining working for the Burnwell Coal Mining Company. Harry's wife Mrs. Julia J Fleetwood was listed as his nearest relative.

In the 1920 Census, Henry Fleetwood is living at the Burnwell mining camp in Walker Co, Alabama. He is 46 years old, born in Georgia, as were his parents, and is superintendent of a coal mine. Living with him are his wife Julia, 47, born in Alabama, and daughter Sara, 10, also born in Alabama.

Harry worked in coal mining, and was a Vice President of his company. He died of heart problems. Sarah was 13 when her father died. [3] Harry actually committed suicide. [CAR]

Harry Fleetwood and his son Harry Hill Fleetwood both suffered from manic depression and both committed suicide. [2] Harry jumped to his death while receiving treatment at a hospital in Mobile, Alabama. [4] Harry's brother Julian may have also suffered from manic depression and also committed suicide just two months before Harry died.

Harry married **Julia Kate Jones**,²⁹ daughter of **John W Jones**³⁵ and **Ann McLeod**,²⁹ on 22 Dec 1897 in Saint Clair County, Alabama.³⁶ Julia was born on 22 Jul 1871 in Cropwell, St. Clair County, Alabama,³⁷ died on 31 Oct 1960 in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama³⁸ at age 89, and was buried in Oak Hill Cemetery, Talladega, Alabama.³⁹ Another name for Julia was Julia Jones.⁴⁰ They had two children: **Harry Hill** and **Sarah**.

Marriage Notes: Harry E Fleetwood married Julia K Jones 22 Dec 1897 in Saint Clair County, Alabama. [1]

General Notes: Julia was born in Croppel, Alabama, near Talladega. Her father worked on the train between Talladega and Pell City. Julia was the youngest of 10; 8 girls and 2 boys.

Julia's father died whe she was one year old. Her oldest sister was already married. Her two brothers went to the University of Alabama. They went to Decatur, AL, and were very successful in the cotton business.

She attended Judson college in Marion, Alabama, for a while, but did not graduate.

Julia's father had land they farmed, and had a general store. The store was built from brick that he made in the brick-making yard he also owned. The store still stands, and is an antique shop.

In the 1930 Census, Julia is living in Birmingham, Alabama, possibly at 1217 North 32nd Street. She is 59 years old and widowed. Julia lists her birthplace as Alabama, her father's as Virginia, and her mother as Alabama. Living with her is her daughter Sarah, 20. Sarah is a hostess at a furniture company. Also living in the house are 2 lodgers, Edward Trotle? and Marie Park.

Noted events in her life were:

- Alt. Birth: Abt 1872, Croppel, Alabama.²⁹
- Alt. Birth: Abt 1872, Cropwell, St. Clair County, Alabama.³⁴
- Alt. Death: 1960, Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama.²⁹

5-**Harry Hill Fleetwood**²⁹ was born on 23 Aug 1900 in Talladega County, Alabama,²⁹ died on 12 Oct 1941 in Tuscaloosa, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama⁴¹ at age 41, and was buried in Tuscaloosa Memorial Park, Tuscaloosa, Alabama.²⁸ The cause of his death was suicide.³²

General Notes: In September 1918, Harry Hill Fleetwood was 18 years old, born August 23 1900, when he registered for the World War I draft. Harry was living at Burnwell Mines, Walker County, Alabama, and was a student. His father H E Fleetwood was listed as his nearest relative.

In the 1920 Census (January), Harry H Fleetwood is living at 1305 St. Charles street in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama. He is 20 years old, born in Alabama, and a manager at a novelty company. Living with him is his wife Robbie, 20, and also born in Alabama.

By December 1920, Harry and Robbie were living in Sanford, Seminole County, Florida, where their daughter Robbie was born. By 1927, they were back in Alabama.

In the 1930 Census, Harry Fleetwood is living on Edgewood Boulevard in

Homewood, Jefferson Co, Alabama. He is 30 years old and was born in Alabama. Harry is a veteran of the World War (WWI). He is a Buyer Salesman in Men's Clothing, owns his home, valued at \$3500, and a radio. Living with him are his wife Robbie, 30, born in Alabama, and daughters Robbie, 9, born in Florida, and Dorothy, 2 years and 4 months, born in Alabama. Harry and Robbie married when they were both 20 years old.

Harry Hill Fleetwood and his father Harry Evans Fleetwood both suffered from manic depression and both committed suicide. [1]

Harry married **Robbie Gray**,¹⁹ daughter of **Albert Gray** and **Stella Redden**, on 4 Dec 1919 in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama.⁴² Robbie was born on 27 Mar 1899 in Sulligent, Lamar Co, Alabama,¹⁹ died on 14 Oct 1976 in Tuscaloosa, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama¹⁹ at age 77, and was buried in Tuscaloosa Memorial Park, Tuscaloosa, Alabama.²³ They had two children: **Robbie Gray "Bobbie"** and **Dorothy Ann**.

General Notes: Robbie Fleetwood was born 27 Mar 1899 and died Oct 1976. Her last residence was in Northport, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama. [1]

Robbie was the mother of Robbie Grey Fleetwood and Dorothy Ann Fleetwood, and the grandmother of Mrs Roger Andrew Newman [Julia Katherine Kratz], Mrs Claude Fuller [Jenna Kratz], Mrs John Martin Smith [Michele Ashurst], Robert Turpin Ashurst IV, and Allen Fleetwood Ashurst. [2]

6-Robbie Gray "Bobbie" Fleetwood²⁸ was born on 20 Dec 1920 in Sanford, Seminole County, Florida,¹⁹ died on 9 Nov 1964 in Montgomery, Montgomery County, Alabama⁴³ at age 43, and was buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Montgomery, Alabama.⁴⁴

General Notes: Mrs Robert Ashurst, the former Bobbie Fleetwood of Tuscaloosa, died Monday of a heart attack after undergoing surgery. [1]

Survivors included her husband Dr Robert Ashurst of Montgomery, daughter Michael Ashurst, a student at the University of Alabama, a son [should be 2 sons], her mother and a sister. [1]

Tuscaloosa County, Alabama.⁴⁵ Robert was born on 16 Jul 1919,⁴⁶ died on 9 Dec 1985⁴⁷ at age 66, and was buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Montgomery, Alabama.⁴⁸ Another name for Robert was Robert T Ashurst.¹⁹ They had three children: **Michele, Robert Turpin, and Alan Fleetwood.**

General Notes: After Robbie's death in 1964, Robert remarried in Montgomery County, Alabama, in October 1965. Currently his spouse is unknown. [2]

Robert Ashurst III was born 16 Jul 1919 and died Dec 1985. His last residence was in Montgomery, Montgomery County, Alabama. [1]

6-Dorothy Ann Fleetwood²⁸ was born on 5 Dec 1927 in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama⁴⁶ and died on 8 May 1999 in McLean, Fairfax County, Virginia⁵¹ at age 71. The cause of her death was brain tumor - glioblastoma multiform.

General Notes: Like many in her family, Dorothy had bipolar disorder. She was treated for it from 1977 until her death in 1999. [2]

Dr. Dorothy Ann Fleetwood Davis died on 8 May 1999 at her residence in McLean, Virginia. She volunteered at the Washington Cathedral for a while, and taught English to International students. She passed away May 8th, 1999 of a Glioblastoma brain tumor. One of the things that sticks out in my mind was what someone said about her at her memorial service. People were sharing stories about her, and this young man told a story about Grandmama always giving him sun catchers. He said that the thing that she didn't realize was that SHE was the sun catcher, always bringing cheer and happiness in other peoples lives. She and I were always close, and everyone says that I am more like her than anyone else. [4]

Dorothy was cremated. Most of her ashes were scattered at Gulf Shores, Alabama. Her daughters and granddaughters each saved some of her ashes for themselves. [3]
