1-Karl Johan Svensson<sup>1</sup> was born on 10 Apr 1855 in Sweden<sup>2</sup> and died on 25 Jan 1889 in Torp, Fliseryd Parish, Kalmar County, Småland Province, Sweden<sup>3</sup> at age 33. Another name for Karl was Carl Johan Svensson.<sup>4</sup>

General Notes: When Karl married Fredrika in 1883, he was a farm foreman in Torp, Fliseryd Parish, Kalmar County, Småland Province. [1]

Karl married **Fredrika Höglander**,<sup>5</sup> daughter of **Johannes Höglander**<sup>7</sup> and **Christina "Stina" Carlsdotter**,<sup>8</sup> on 5 Nov 1883 in Torp, Fliseryd Parish, Kalmar County, Småland Province, Sweden.<sup>6</sup> Fredrika was born on 25 Sep 1853 in Flugenäs, Frödinge Parish, Kalmar County, Småland Province, Sweden,<sup>9</sup> died on 8 Sep 1926 in Glendale, Los Angeles County, California<sup>10</sup> at age 72, and was buried on 11 Sep 1926 in Forest Lawn Cemetery, Glendale, California.<sup>11</sup> Other names for Fredrika were Frederick Hoglander<sup>12</sup> and Fredericka Hoglander.<sup>10</sup> They had three children: **Carl Axel Helge, Robert Wallentin**, and **Joseph Jordan**.

General Notes: Fredrika was 10 years old when her mother died in January 1864.

<u>31-Dec 1867</u> - Fredrika Höglander, comes from Frödinge, to Förlösa No 3, Förlösa Parish, Kalmar, and lives with her sister and brother-in-law Sophie & JP Westberg. [6]

Fredrika Svensson was from Fliseryd Kalmar Län, Sverige (Sweden). [4]

Regarding the Swensons:

The three Swenson Brothers and their mother were brought to the U.S. by the Hager's. Mrs Swenson may have been Marie's sister. Mrs. Swenson was sick, possibly diabetic, and could not care for her sons. The three brothers were split between the children of John & Marie (Annie, Charles, Bessie) to raise. Axle and Robert died young (age 10 and 18) and were buried in the Hager family plot at Oak Hill Cemetary, Birmingham, Alabama. Joe was raised by Annie Hager Jordan, and survived to adulthood.

Mrs Swenson either died and was buried in California, or was buried in Joe Swenson's plot, which may be at Oak Hill Cemetary. [2]

The Swenson brothers' father was Joseph J. Swenson. They came to Alabama from Sweden in 1890. [John W. Hager's notes] However, Fredericka's death certificate states her husband was Carl Swenson, and they actually arrived in 1892.

Fredericka Svensson and her three sons Carl [Axle], 8, Robert, 6, and Josef, 4, left Göteborg (Gothenburg, Sweden) on 28 October 1892 on the ship Ariosto for Glasgow, Scotland, with a final destination of the United States. They arrived in New York City November 17, 1892, on the ship Ethiopia, sailing from Glasgow. They traveled with Fredericka's sister Marie Hager (Mary on the passenger list) and her son Charles. Marie, her husband John Hager, and two of their children had previously immigrated to the United States in 1870. [3, 4, 7]

Fredericka and her three sons were brought to the US by John and Marie Hager. Fredericka was Marie's sister. Mrs. Swenson was sick, possibly diabetic, and could not care for her sons. The brothers were split between the children of John and Marie Hager to raise. [Karlene Hager Trimble]

John Hager actually died the year before the Swenson's emigrated. [CAR]

In 1893 Mrs Frederic Swenson is living in Birmingham in the Woodlawn station area with her niece Annie and son-in-law Henry L Jordan, and Marie's sister Mrs Mary Hager. [1]

Axle and Robert died young and are buried in the Hager family plot at Oak Hill Cemetary, Birmingham, AL. [KHT]

Joe survived to adulthood. He and his mother lived with Annie Hager and Henry Jordan in Atlanta. After Joe's marriage and move to California, Fredericka went to live with them. She was buried in California when she passed away. [KHT]

In the 1900 Census, Fredericka Swenson (Freode Swinson on the census) is living in Woodlawn, Jefferson Co, Alabama, with her niece Annie Hager and Annie's husband Henry L Jordan. Frederick is 40, born Oct 1853 in Sweden, and widowed. She has had 3 children and 1 is living (should be 2 living). Also with her is her son Joe, 9. Joe was born May 1887 in Sweden.

In the 1910 Census, Fredericka Swenson is living in Atlanta, Georgia, with her niece Annie Hager Jordan and her husband Henry Lee Jordan. She is 55 years old, born in Sweden, and immigrated in 1892. She speaks English. Fredericka is widowed, and the mother of 3 children, only 1 is living.

In the 1920 Census, Fredericka (Fraedeck Sevson on the Census) is living in Atlanta, Georgia, with her niece Annie Hager Jordan and her husband Henry Jordan. The Census lists her year of immigration as 1894. She is not a citizen, and she does speak English.

Fredericka's death certificate in 1926 states she had lived in Glendale 2 years, and in California 10 years. She was still in Atlanta in 1920, so it is unlikely she moved to California before then.

Her grave marker shows her name as Fredrika Swenson. [5]

2-**Carl Axel Helge Svensson**<sup>15</sup> was born on 2 Nov 1884 in Fliseryd, Kalmar, Sweden,<sup>16</sup> died on 18 Jun 1894 in Jefferson County, Alabama<sup>17</sup> at age 9, and was buried on 17 Jun 1894 in Oak Hill Cemetery, Birmingham, Alabama.<sup>18</sup> Other names for Carl were Carl Svensson<sup>13</sup> and Axle H. Swenson. Noted events in his life were:

• Immigration: 17 Nov 1892.<sup>13</sup>

2-**Robert Wallentin Svensson**<sup>15</sup> was born on 6 Mar 1886 in Fliseryd, Kalmar, Sweden,<sup>15</sup> died on 13 Feb 1904 in Jefferson County, Alabama<sup>17</sup> at age 17, and was buried on 14 Feb 1904 in Oak Hill Cemetery, Birmingham, Alabama.<sup>18</sup> Other names for Robert were Robert Svensson<sup>13</sup> and Robert Swenson.

General Notes: Robert Svensson was from Fliseryd Kalmar Län, Sverige (Sweden). [1]

In the 1900 Census, Robert is living with George and Bessie Hager Stevenson in Bessemer, Jefferson County, Alabama. He is 14 years old, born in March 1886. He immigrated from Sweden in 1888, and had been in the US for 12 years. [Actual immigration was 1892.]

2-Joseph Jordan Swenson was born on 15 May 1887 in Fliseryd, Kalmar, Sweden,<sup>15</sup> died on 14 Sep 1958 in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama<sup>19</sup> at age 71, and was buried in Elmwood Cemetery, Birmingham, Alabama. Another name for Joseph was Josef Emanuel Svensson.<sup>20</sup>

General Notes: Josef Svensson was from Fliseryd Kalmar Län, Sverige (Sweden). [2] He was the son of Karl Swenson and Fredrica. [3]

Josef Svensson's last foreign residence was Iskarshamn, Sweden. He immigrated from Göteborg (Gothenburg, Sweden), arriving on 17 November 1892 at New York on the ship Tehiopia [should be Ethiopia]. [4]

Joe and his mother lived with Annie Hager and Henry Jordan in Atlanta. In appreciation for all the things Henry Jordan did for him, Joe took Jordan as his middle name. He married a woman named Genae [Bell]. They had two sons, Bob and Joe, Jr. They moved to California and Mrs. Swenson came to live with them there. She is buried in California. [1]

Joseph was living in Kansas City, Missouri, in 1915 & 1916 when he submitted his first Declaration of Intention to become a US citizen. [4]

Joseph and Genae moved to Berkley, California, about 1916 or 1917.

On June 5 1917, Joseph J Swenson registered for the World War I draft. Joseph was born May 15 1887 in Oskersham (sp?), Sweden, and he is still a citizen of Sweden. Joseph is living at 2841 Prince (?) Street in Berkley, Alameda County, California. He is a sales manager for American Cast Iron Pipe Company in San Francisco. Joseph is supporting his wife, child, and mother. Joseph's birthplace is probably Oskarshamn, Kalmar, Sweden.

In the 1920 Census, Joseph is living in Berkely, Alameda County, California. Living with him are his wife Genae B, and their sons Joseph J, Jr, age 5, born in Alabama, and Robert J,

age 2 months, born in California. The census shows Joseph's year of immigration as 1899, and his citizenship status as pending. He is a salesman for a cast iron company.

In 1926, Joseph and his family were living in Glendale, Los Angeles County, California, when his mother Fredericka died there.

In the 1930 Census, Joseph is living in Jefferson County, Alabama in Precinct 25, at 55 Southwood Road. Southwood Road is in the Vestavia Hills area of Birmingham. Living with Joseph is his wife Genae B, and their sons Joseph J, Jr, age 15, born in Alabama, and Robert J, age 10, born in California. Joseph and Genae were married at age 26 & 22, respectively. Also living with them is Genae's mother Cora B. Bell, age 68, and Gertrude Salton(?), a Negro servant. Joseph is a salesman for a pipe foundry. The Census lists his immigration as 1891, and that he is not a citizen. They own a radio set.

On 20 June 1935, at Birmingham, Joseph declared his intention to become a US citizen. [4]

A copy of the following obituary was found in the files of the Hager family plot at Oak Hill Cemetery in Birmingham, AL. It was sent to the Oak Hill Memorial association by John W. Hager in June 1972. The obituary was undated, but the year of Joseph's death was confirmed by his gravestone at Elmwood Cemetery. He was living in Birmingham when he died. The obituary was printed in a company publication of the American Cast Iron Pipe Company.

The many friends of the American Cast Iron Company who knew him personally, will undoubtedly regret to learn of the death of Joseph J. Swenson, former vice president in charge of sales and secretary of our Company, on September 14. Funeral services were held on September 17 at the Independent Presbyterian Church in Birmingham. Born in Sweden, Mr. Swenson came to America as a young man and was graduated from the University of Georgia in 1907. He began his employment with AMERICAN in July of that year, starting as timekeeper. Advancing in various sales capacities, he served the Company in Birmingham, Kansas City and the West Coast. Appointed general sales manager in January, 1927, he subsequently became vice president in charge of sales and secretary, which positions he held at the time of his retirement in May, 1952. Mr. Swenson

also served on the Company Board of Directors from 1927 until the time of his retirement. Shortly after retiring, Mr. Swenson became city manager of Mountain Brook, Alabama, in early 1953, serving in this capacity until September, 1957.

An active member of the Independent Presbyterian Church, Mr. Swenson had served as an Elder and was a former president of the congregation. He was greatly interested in the Fresh Air Farm Program of his church and served as trustee for this work; and had also taken an active role in support of the Birmingham Boys Club. He was a Mason and a Kiwanian.

Mr. Swenson is survived by two sons, Joseph Jordan Swenson, Jr., Whittier, California, and Robert Jerome Swenson, Birmingham; three grandchildren; and an aunt, Mrs. Henry L. Jordan, of Birmingham.

Joseph, his wife Genae, and son Robert are buried in Elmwood Cemetery in Birmingham with Genea's parents Walter and Cora Bell.

Joseph married **Genae Bell**,<sup>23</sup> daughter of **Dr. Walter H. Bell**<sup>25</sup> and **Cora Isabel Robertson**,<sup>26</sup> on 14 Aug 1913 in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama.<sup>24</sup> Genae was born on 11 Dec 1892 in Belltown, Cleburne County, Alabama,<sup>27</sup> died on 24 Dec 1957 in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama<sup>28</sup> at age 65, and was buried on 26 Dec 1957 in Elmwood Cemetery, Birmingham, Alabama.<sup>25</sup> They had two children: **Joseph Jordan** and **Robert Jerome**.

Marriage Notes: Reported in the Atlanta newspaper from the Birmingham news - Joseph Hordan Swenson married Genea Bell Thursday morning [14 Aug 1913] at First Presbyterian Church [Birmingham]. After the ceremony Mr & Mrs Swenson left to spend several weeks at Wrightsville Beach [North Carolina, near Wilmington]. Afterward they will reside at Woodland avenue, North Haven. Mr. Swenson was described as from a prominent Georgia family.

Attending from out of town were, among others, Mr & Mrs Jordan of Atlanta and Mrs Swenson, mother of the groom, from Atlanta. [1]

3-Joseph Jordan Swenson Jr<sup>12</sup> was born on 24 May 1914 in Verbena, Chilton County, Alabama<sup>30</sup> and died on 16 Nov 1986 in San Diego County, California<sup>31</sup> at age 72.

General Notes: In the 1958, when his father died, Joseph was living in Whittier, California. [Joseph Swenson Sr, obituary]

Joseph Jordan Swenson (mother's maiden name - Bell) was born 24 May 1914 in Alabama, and died 16 Nov 1986 in San Diego County, California. His last residence was in Fallbrook, San Diego County. [1, 2]

Olive M. Swenson born 31 Jan 1916, died 14 Apr 1998. Her last residence was in Lakewood, Jefferson Co, Colorado. Her Social Security number was issued in California (1952-1953). [2]

Olive Moses Swenson, 82, of Denver died April 14. Memorial services were April 19. Mrs. Swenson was born Olive Moses. She married Joseph Swenson, 1936. She was a member of the Pi Beta Phi sorority. Survivors include daughters Bette Sargent, Mary Forman, both of Denver; son Joseph III of Denver; brother Charles Moses Jr.; six grandchildren; three great-grandchildren. [1]

3-**Robert Jerome Swenson**<sup>41</sup> was born on 13 Oct 1919 in Berkeley, Alameda County, California,<sup>42</sup> died on 21 Dec 1991<sup>25</sup> at age 72, and was buried in Elmwood Cemetery, Birmingham, Alabama. Another name for Robert was Robert Jerome Russell Swenson.<sup>43</sup>

General Notes: Robert J Swenson was born 13 Oct 1919 in Alameda County, California, [1] probably in Berkely where the family was living in 1917-1920. [1]

In October 1940 Robert Jerome Swenson registered for the draft in Swanee, Franklin County, Tennessee, where he is a student at the University of the South. His permanent residence is at his parents' home in Birmingham. Robert was born 13 Oct 1919 in Berkeley, California. [9]

On 19 June 1941 Robert J Swenson enlisted in the US Army at Fort McClellan, Alabama. Robert was born in 1919 in California. He was living in Jefferson County, Alabama when he enlisted as a private in the Philippine Department. Robert had 3 years of college at the time and was single. [2]

In 1944 Robt J Swenson is listed in the Birmingham city directory at his parents' home. He is in the USA [US Army]. [8]

In 1949, Robert served as a pallbearer at his Aunt Bessie Hager Stevenson's funeral. Burial was in Oak Hill Cemetery in Birmingham.

In the 1958, when his father died, Robert was living in Birmingham, Alabama. [Joseph Swenson Sr, obituary]

In 1959 & 1960 Robt J Swenson is living in the home he shared with his parents (before their deaths) at 2901 Southwood rd in Mountain Brook. He is the proprietor of Bob Swenson's Gift Shop at 1822 12th av S in Birmingham. [8]

Robert has a brief marriage. [5] Robert Jerome Russell Swenson (son of Jospeh & Genae) married Betty (Pearce) Westfall on 16 Jan 1960. [6, 7]

Robert J. Swenson was born 13 Oct 1919 and died 21 Dec 1991. [3]

Robert Jerome Swenson was living in Mountain Brook (Birmingham), Alabama, at the time of his death. He was a graduate of the University of the South (in Tennessee), and employed at Cumberland School of Law library. He was a member of the Cathedral

Church of the Advent. [4]

Robert married **Betty Pearce**,<sup>43</sup> daughter of **James Gibson Pearce** and **Edna Bate**, on 16 Jan 1960 in Jefferson County, Alabama.<sup>44</sup> The marriage ended in divorce. Betty was born on 2 Aug 1928 in Winfield, Marion County, Alabama<sup>45</sup> and died on 1 Dec 1998 in Alabama<sup>46</sup> at age 70. They had no children.

Navy Department as an Administrative Assistant, Royal Crown Bottling Co. as Office Manager and Cobb Travel as a Tour Agent. She was past Alabama Regent of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Past National Chairman of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Past President of the Civiettes Club and the Antiquarian Society.
