1-Edward Herbert,¹ son of **David Herbert** and **Jane Gibbon**, was born on 3 September 1848 in Colwinston parish, Glamorgan county, Wales² and died on 17 January 1884 in Aetnaville, Belmont County, Ohio³ at age 35.

General Notes: Edward has not been found in Wales after 1861, either on the census or the death index. [CAR - Apr 2014]

Edward is probably the Edward Herbert, age 22, from England, who arrived in New York City on 30 November 1870 on the ship City of Brussels, sailing from Liverpool, England, and Queenstown, Ireland. Edward is a laborer. [2]

Edward Herbert, born in South Wales, was naturalized in Belmont County, Ohio, on 22 September 1877. William J Howells was his witness. [4]

In 1880 Edward Herbert, age 31 (born about 1849 in Wales), is living in Bridgeport, Belmont County, Ohio. He is a bank boss of rolling mill coal bank. With Edward are his wife Harriet, 24, born in Wales, and children Mary Anna, 2, Sarah J, 1, and David Daniel, 3 months, born in February. All the children were born in Ohio. [1]

The Wheeling Valley Coal Company was incorporated in March 1882 with capital of 815.000 [sic]. [10] No principals of the company were named; Edward Herbert was a likely founder.

In February 1883 the Belmont Chronicle reported that the Wheeling Valley coal company was in difficulties primarily due to a disagreement amoung themsleves on the conduct of business. [8]

In 1883 Edward Herbert and Jos. Plows were the pricipals involved in the Wheeling Valley Coal Company when it was declared insolvent and a sale was ordered. [9]

Early December 1883 - "Edward Herbert, who has been so sorely afflicted, is now, we are glad to know, nicely improving." [6]

Edward Herbert, son of David & Jane Herbert, died 17 January 1884 in Aetnaville, Belmont County, Ohio. He was 36 (born about 1848 in Wales), and a miner. [3]

"Edward Herbert, a coal operator of this place [Bridgeport, OH], died yesterday, after a lingering illness, aged 42 years." (Should be 35 years.) [5]

[Edward's uncle] Lewis Jones [of Wheeling, West Virginia] was the administrator of Edward's estate. Throughout 1886 Lewis attempted to auction two lots in Aetnaville, Ohio, that were appraised at \$2000. [7]

Edward married **Harriet Jobe**, ⁴ daughter of **David Jobe** and **Sarah Davis**,. Harriet was born on 26 April 1856 in Wales, ⁵ died on 4 September 1930 in Martins Ferry, Belmont County, Ohio ⁶ at age 74, and was buried on 7 September 1930 in Weeks Cemetery, Bridgeport, Belmont County, Ohio. ⁷ They had five children: **Mary Anna, Sarah J "Jennie," David Daniel, Harriet "Hattie,"** and **Mary Ann "Mayme"**.

General Notes: In 1851 Harriet's parents David and Sarah Job are living in Aberdare village, Merthyr Tydfil, Glamorgan, Wales. Harriet's sister Mary Hannah is 1, born in Blaina, Monmouthshire. David is 21, born in Risca, Monmouthshire, and a puddler. Sarah is 22, born in Merthyr Tydfil, Glamorgan. They are living with David's mother Harriet Job, and his three older brothers. [5]

In 1861 Harriet Job is living in Middlesbrough village, Yorkshire, England. She is 4 years old, born in Wales. Harriet is living with her parents David & Sarah Job (David is a roller), and siblings Mary Hannah, 11, David, 7, Benjamin, 1. All were born in Wales except Benjamin, born in Middlesbrough. The three older children, ages 11 to 4, are laborers. [4]

In 1870 Harriet Job is living in Bedford, Cuyahoga County, Ohio. She is 15, born in Wales. Harriet is living with her parents David & Sarah Job (David is a puddler at an R. [rolling?] mill), brother Benjamin [age 1, should be 10], sister Jane, 9, and sister Sarah, 2. All were born in Wales except sister Sarah. Also in the house are four boarders. [3]

When Edward died in January 1884, Harriet had two young children and another on the way. Daughter Mary Ann was born a month after Edward died.

On 31 December 1885, Mrs Harriet Herbert married James B Griminger, in Belmont County, Ohio. [1]

In 1900 Harriet and James B Griminger are living in Bridgeport, Belmont County, Ohio. They have been married 14 years. Harriet has had 14 children, 7 are living. James is a "Healin Lin Mill". Living with them are daughter Mary A Griminger [should be Herbert], 16, children Margaretta, 13. James E, 8, and Clara E, 5. [6]

In 1910 Hariet and James B Griminger are living in Bridgeport. James is 49, on his 1st marriage, and a merchant with his own grocery store. Hariet is 54, has had 14 children, 7 are living. With them are Mamie Herbert, Claretta Griminger and James E Griminger. [7]

Harriet and James' daughter Margaretta Mitchell died 11 March 1917. [8]

In 1920 Harriett and James B Grimminger are living in Bridgeport. Harriet is 63, immigrated 1870, naturalized 1880. James is 59, no occupation. With them are Harriet's daughter Mamie Herbert and their grandchildren Hazel L Mitchell, 10, James Mitchell, 9, Elvaray Mitchell, 6, and Marjorie Mitchell, 4. [10]

In 1930 Harriet and James B Grimminger are living in Martins Ferry. James is retired. [11]

Harriett Grimminger, daughter of Benjamin Jobe and Sarah Davis, died 4 September 1930 in Martins Ferry, Ohio. She was born 26 April 1856 in Wales. Harriet died of chronic endocarditis [inflamation of the heart]. She also had an umbilical hernia that she had suffered from for 30 years. Harriet's husband James B Grimminger was the informant on her death certificate. Burial was in Weeks Cemetery, Bridgeport. [2]

Harriet's widower James Baine Grimminger died at Martins Ferry on 6 December 1937. [9]

 - 2-Mary Anna Herbert⁸ was born on 23 June 1877 in Bridgeport, Belmont County, Ohio⁹ and died on 15 September 1882 in Bridgeport, Belmont County, Ohio¹⁰ at age 5.

General Notes: Herbert - September 15, 1882, in Bridgeport, Ohio, a little over 5 years old, Mary Anna, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Herbert, from scarlet fever again. The two girls [here the writer, probably her uncle William Herbert, is referring to another child whose obituary is on the same page] were only sick a few days. They were buried in the Bridgeport Cemetery. The funeral service was given by the Rev. W. Lewis. [1]

General Notes: In 1900 Jennie Herbert is living in Wheeling, Ohio County, West Virginia, in the home of Harlan and Lucy McGregor. She is 21, born November 1878 in Ohio, and a servant. Her parents were both born in Wales. [2]

On 6 March 1901 Jennie Herbert married Samuel James in Wheeling, West Virginia. Both were residents of Bridgeport, Ohio. Jennie was 21 [should be about 22], born in Aetnaville, Ohio. [3]

Jennie James, daughter of Edward Herbert and Harriet Jobe, died 30 September 1926 in Martins Ferry, Ohio. She was born 16 November 1877 [should be 1878] in Bridgeport. She died of cardiac delotobum [?] myocarditis, and of toxic goitre. She was married to Samuel James. [1]

His cousin David Herbert (son of William and Margaret) also died there on 5 December 1880. [see David Herbert]

Harriet married **Robert Emmet Dever**, ²² son of **Henry Dever** and **Mary Landmire**, on 5 December 1906 in Belmont County, Ohio. ²³ Robert was born in 1879 in Martins Ferry, Belmont County, Ohio, ²⁴ died on 12 February 1967²⁵ at age 88, and was buried in Saint Marys Cemetery, Martins Ferry, Belmont County, Ohio. ²⁵ They had three children: **Sarah Cecelia, Virginia Mae**, and **Estella M**.

General Notes: In 1906, when Robert married Harriet, he was living in Martins Ferry, Ohio, and was a tin heater. [1]

She was survived by stepson Donald Hughes of New Jersey, three grandchildren, several nieces and nephews including Robert (Shirley) Hall of Cupertino, California. [1]

2-Mary Ann "Mayme" Herbert⁴¹ was born on 12 February 1884 in Aetnaville, Belmont County, Ohio,⁴² died on 15 May 1971 in Morgantown, Monogalia County, West Virginia⁴³ at age 87, and was buried on 18 May 1971 in Lawnwood Cemetery, Morgantown, Monogalia County, West Virginia.⁴³ She never married and had no children.

General Notes: Mary Ann was born a month after the death of her father.

In 1900 Mary A Griminger [should be Herbert] is living in Bridgeport, Ohio, with her mother Harriet and [step] father James B Griminger. She is 16, born February 1884 in Ohio. [2]

In 1910 Mamie Herbert is living in Bridgeport with her mother Hariet & step-father James B Griminger. She is 26, born in Ohio. No occupation is listed for her. [3]

In 1920 Mamie Herbert is living in Bridgeport with her mother Harriet and step-father James B

Grimminger, and nieces & nephew Hazel L Mitchell, James Mitchell, Elvaray Mitchell and Marjorie Mitchell. Mamie is 35; no occupation is listed. [4]

In 1930 Mayme Herbert is living in Morgantown, Monongalia County, West Virginia, with her [half-sister] Claretta C Gosney and her husband Chester C Gosney, and their son Woodroe H Gosney. Mayme is 45, no occupation. Chester is a com. traveler in the meat industry. [5]

In 1935 they are living in Clarksburg, Harrison County, West Virginia. [6]

In 1940 Mayme Herbert is living in Clarksburg. She is 56, completed the 8th grade. She is living with the Gosneys. [6]

Miss Mayme Herbert, daughter of Edward Herbert and Harriett Jobe, died 15 May 1971 at Sundale Rest Home in Morgantown, Monongalia, West Virginia, of pulmonary embolus due to cystic lung disease and bronchial asthma. The informant on her death certificate was [half-sister Clara Grimminger] Mrs. Chester C. Gosney of Morgantown. [1]
