1-**Alford Davis**<sup>1</sup> was born on 28 Sep 1820 in Alabama,<sup>2</sup> died on 15 Apr 1892<sup>3</sup> at age 71, and was buried in Alford Davis Family Cemerty, Marion County, Alabama.<sup>4</sup> Another name for Alford was Alfred Davis.<sup>5</sup>

General Notes: In 1850 Alfred Davis is living in Marion County, Alabama. He is 28, born in Alabama, and a farmer. Alfred's real estate is worth \$785. Living with Alfred are his wife Sarah A, 20, and son Samuel M, 8 months. [2]

In 1860 Alford Davis is living in Marion County. He is 35 and farming. Alford owns real estate worth \$300 and personal estate of \$635. Living with Alford are his wife Sarah, 30, children Mack [Samuel], 11, Caroline, 8, Jane, 6, Alexander [Elic], 3, Mary, 2, and the baby [Gardner], age 5 months. [3]

On 31 August 1865 Alford Davis signed the oat of allegiance required of all who supported the Confederacy in order for them to regain their citizenship rights. [1] At this time it is not known if Alford served in the Confederate army or the state militia during the War. [CAR]

In 1870 Alfred Davis is living in Marion County, Alabama. He is 50, born in Alabama, and a farmer. He has real estate valued at \$200 and personal property of \$525. Wife Sarah is 49 and also born in Alabama. With them are their children Samuel M, 20, Caroline, 16, Edmund M [Elic], 13, Gardner, 10, Cumile, 8, Jeremiah, 3, and Martha A, 1. [4]

In 1880 Alfred Davis is living in Marion County. He is 60, born in Alabama as were his parents, and farming. Wife Sarah A is 50, also born in Alabama as were her parents. With them are their children Susan C, 25. Elleck M (Elic), 23, Gardner C, 20, Martha A [Cummie], 17, Jerry F, 12, George Ann, 9, and [daughter] Beady M, 6. [5]

Alford married **Sarah A B McCarley**. Sarah was born on 17 Jan 1830 in Alabama, died on 5 Apr 1897 at age 67, and was buried in Alford Davis Family Cemerty, Marion County, Alabama. Other names for Sarah were Sarah Ann B<sup>1</sup> and Sara McCurley. They

had 11 children: Samuel Mack, Louisa Jane, Susan Caroline, Elic Magnis, Mary, Gardner Knapp, Qumine "Cummie," Jerry F, Martha A, Georgia Anna, and Paralee.

General Notes: Death certificates (transcription) for Georgia Anna, Gardner, & Paralee show Sarah as McCurley, McCurby or McCorley.

2-Samuel Mack Davis<sup>10</sup> was born in Apr 1850 in Alabama. 11

General Notes: On the 1850 Census, Samuel was 8 months old. The official enumeration date was 1 July 1850; the Davis family was enumerated on 18 December. Samuel would have been born in September 1849 if the census taker followed instructions, or about April 1850. [1]

In 1880, Samuel M Davis is living in Marion County, Alabama, next to his parents. Samuel is 29 and a farmer. With him are his wife Julia A, 26, and sons Henry S, 4, Albert S, 2, and Peter F, 4 months, born in Feb 1880. [2]

In 1900 Samuel M Davis is living in Coles Mill, Franklin County, Alabama. He is 50, and a farmer. With him are his wife Julia Ann, 46. Julia has had 7 children, all are living. With them are their children Albert S, 22, Peter F, 20, Charley U, 17, Josie, 15, Abilene V, 10, and Nellie May, 3. Son Henry and his wife Leora are living next door. [3]

General Notes: In 1880 Eliza [Louisa] J Holt and husband John N Holt are living in Franklin County, Alabama. Both are 28, born in Alabama. John is a farmer. With them are their children Mindy I, 8, Wm S, 5, Lou Kitty, 2, and Rody R, 3 months. [2]

Louisa and John moved to Arkansas about 1892.

In 1900 Louise J and husband John N Holt are living in Lick Mountain, Conway County, Arkansas. Louise is 47, born in Alabama. She has had 9 children, 6 are living. John is 48, a farmer, also born in Alabama, his parents in North Carolina. They have been married 27 years. With them are their children Mindy I, 23 [should be about 28], Curry M, 16, Wooster W, 9, and Roxie A, 6. All were born in Alabama, except Roxie, born in Arkansas. [3]

Lou Isa and her husband J N Holt moved to Oklahoma. [1]

In 1910 Louisa and John N Holt are living in Dow township, Pittsburg County, Oklahoma. They have been married 39 years [abt 1871]. Louisa has had 9 children, only 6 are living. With them are son Wooster, 19, daughter Roxie, 15, and granddaughter Maggie Holt, 12. [4]

In 1920 Louisa and John N Holt are living in Summerfield township, Le Flore County, Oklahoma. Louisa and John are 65 and 67 years old, born in Alabama. John is a farmer. With them is daughter Roxey, 25, and a school teacher. Living next door (or possibly with them) is son William and his family. [5]

Louisa married **John Newton Holt**<sup>18</sup> about 1873.<sup>11</sup> John was born in Aug 1857 in Alabama, <sup>11</sup> died on 10 May 1940 in Dewey, Washington County, Oklahoma<sup>19</sup> at age 82, and was buried in Dewey Cemetery, Dewey, Washington County, Oklahoma.<sup>19</sup> Other names for John were J N Holt<sup>1</sup> and John N Holt.<sup>13</sup> They had seven children: **Isabella** "Belle," William Sherman, Lou Kitty, Rody R, Curry Miles, Wooster Winchester, and Roxie A.

General Notes: In 1930 John N Holt is living in Alderson, Pittsburg County, Oklahoma, with daughter Isabell Hull. John is 77. His occupation is "none" (or retired). [1]

General Notes: In 1930 Isabell Hull is living in Alderson, Pittsburg County, Oklahoma, with her father John N Holt. Isabell is 53, born in Alabama, owns her home valued at \$12,000. Neither Isabell or her father are working. [1]

3-**William Sherman Holt**<sup>18</sup> was born on 4 Oct 1874 in Alabama, <sup>20</sup> died on 4 Dec 1960<sup>21</sup> at age 86, and was buried in Muse Cemetery, Spiro, Le Flore County, Oklahoma. <sup>21</sup> Another name for William was William S Holt. <sup>13</sup>

General Notes: In 1900 William S Holt is living in Lick Mountain, Conway County, Arkansas. He is 24 and a farmer. Wife Lida B is 25, born in Arkansas, her parents in Georgia and Illinois. With them are their daughters twins Dovie A & Jessie A, 5, and Maggie, 2. [1]

William and Lydia divorced between 1901 & 1904. By 1905 William had married his 2nd wife, currently unknown. Based on the 1920 Census, the age of 3rd wife Victoria (27) and the gap in age between the youngest two children (age 10 & 1), I assume the oldest three children with him in 1920 had a different mother. This is partially confirmed by the death certificate of daughter Mattie in 1962. [CAR]

In 1918 William Sherman Holt is a farmer living in Summerfield, LeFlore County, Oklahoma. His closest relative is [wife] Victoria Holt. [4]

In 1920 William S Holt is living in Summerfield township, Le Flore County, Oklahoma, next door to his parents. William is 40, born in Alabama, and a farmer. With him are his wife Victoria, 27, born in Arkansas, and children Mary E, 15, Hellen, 12, George T, 10, and daughter Osie, 1 year and 3 months. All the children were born in Oklahoma. [2]

In 1930 William S Holt is living in Muse township, Le Flore County, Oklahoma. He is 51 and a miller at his own grist mill. William owns his home valued at \$300. With William are his wife Victoria, 37, and children Orval, 8, Pearl, 5, and Hazel, 1 year and 2 months. Also in the house are Vinie and Myrtle Holt, 24 & 23 years old, both born in Arkansas. They were married at age 19 & 18, abt 1925. [3]

Lydia was born in May 1875 in Arkansas.<sup>11</sup> Other names for Lydia were Lida B, <sup>11</sup> Lydia Bell Rodgers, <sup>25</sup> Lida Rogers, <sup>26</sup> and Lydia Rogers.<sup>27</sup> They had four children: **Dovie Bell, Jessie Belle, Maggie**, and **Earnest J**.

General Notes: After her divorce from William Holt, Lydia married Tom Ward. [2] They also divorced.

On 1 October 1903, Mrs Lydia Rogers (age 26 of Wooster, Faulkner County, Arkansas) married T H Ward (age 60 of Wooster). [3]

In 1910 Lydia Rodgers is living in Bradley township, Van Buren County, Arkansas. Lydia is 34 and divorced. Lydia has had 5 children, 4 are living. It should be 5 living, as daughter Maggie is living with her grandparents in Oklahoma. Lydia is a farmer. Her oldest three children at home are working as farm laborers. With her are children Jessie & Dovie Holt, age 15, Earnest Holt, 9, and Clyde Ward, 2. [1]

General Notes: Dovie Bell Freeman, daughter of William Holt (born in Alabama) and Lida Rogers (born in Alabama [should be Arkansas], was born 25 December 1897 [should be 1894] died 6 January 1957 in Wichita Falls, Texas, of a coronary occlusion. C M Freeman was the informant on her death certificate. [1]

4-**Jessie Belle Holt**<sup>28</sup> was born in Dec 1894 in Arkansas,<sup>11</sup> died on 15 Apr 1950 in Wichita Falls, Wichita County, Texas<sup>28</sup> at age 55, and was buried on 16 Apr 1950 in Rosemont Cemetery, Wichita Falls, Wichita Co, Texas.<sup>28</sup> Another name for Jessie was Jessie Holt.<sup>11</sup>

General Notes: Jessie Belle Starnes, daughter of William S Holt & Lydia Belle Rodgers, both born in Arkansas [should be Alabama & Arkansas] was born 25 December 1897 [should be 1894] in Arkansas. She died 15 April 1950 in Wichita Falls, Texas, of carcinoma of the cervix. The informant on her death certificate was Zack Starnes. [1]
