Descendants of Nicholas Reuther

1-**Nicholas Reuther**, son of **Johann Adam Reuther**¹ and **Anna Eva Schuster**¹, was born about 1819 in Trogen, Oberfranken District, Bavaria, Germany² and died about Sep 1876 in Probably Clinton County, Pennsylvania³ about age 57.

General Notes: According to Hilda Zimmerman Jeffries, Adam and Nicholas Reuther were brothers. Hilda was a daughter of Jacob and Matilda Laura Amm Zimmerman. Matilda was the daughter of Frederick and Caroline Reuther Amm, and granddaughter of Adam Reuther. [Mary Lamey Hoffer, 2004]

Nicol. Reuther and his son Herm. immigrated in 1870. They arrived in New York City on 30 July 1870 on the ship Union from Bremen, Germany. Nicholas was 51 years old, and from the city of Hof (in Bavaria). [1]

On 9 February 1874, Nicholas declared his intention to become a US citizen. The clerk recorded his name as Nicholas Reuter, and Nicholas signed the document Nicolis Reuther. He was 54 years old, born in Trogen, Bavaria, and immigrated at New York 2 Aug 1870. Nicholas was sworn in as a US citizen on 14 February 1876. He signed the citizenship document Nikol Reuther.

On 30 January 1875, Nicholas purchased 16+ acres from John and Hulda Rarig in Greene township, Clinton County, PA, for \$244.

Nicholas died about September 1876, probably in Clinton County, Pennsylvania, where his estate was probated. A notice dated 4 October 1876 in the newspaper refers to Letters of Administration being granted on the estate of Nicholas Reuther, deceased. [2]

Other notes:

Deed dated 31 March 1943 between Della Lamey & E W Lamey and Jesse Reuther. The deed refers to the land as that which Nicholas purchased in 1875, and that passed to his son Herman about 1878 after Nicholas died intestate. (from Mary Hoffer)

Noted events in his life were:

Nicholas married someone. He had one son: **Herman John**.

2-**Herman John Reuther**⁵ was born on 12 Aug 1860 in Bayern (Bavaria), Germany,⁶ died on 27 Feb 1920 in Green Township, Clinton County, Pennsylvania⁷ at age 59, and was buried on 2 Mar 1920 in Brungard's Cemetery, Greene Twp, Clinton County, Pennsylvania.⁸ The cause of his death was tuberculosis. Another name for Herman was Nick.

General Notes: Birth record for Herman's son Jesse recorded Herman's full name as Herman John Reuther as does his death certificate. [2, 5]

Herman was known as "Nick" after his father and to distinguish him from his first cousin Herman G Reuther. [3]

Herman was probably born in the village of Trogen in Bavaria where his father and uncle were born, or in the city of Hof, Bavaria, where he and his father immigrated from.

Herm. Reuther immigrated with his father Nicol. Reuther in 1870. They arrived in New York City on 30 July 1870 on the ship Union from Bremen, Germany. Herman was 9 years old, and from the city of Hof (in Bavaria). [note 1; 1910 Census]

Herman was about 16 years old when his father died about September 1876, just six years after they arrived in the United States.

On the 1880 Census, Herman J Reuther is living in Greene Township, Clinton County, Pennsylvania, with Frederick Amm (Aunn) and his family. He is 19 years old, born in Bayern/Bavaria, and is a farm laborer. He is a cousin of Frederick's wife Caroline.

On the 1900 Census, Herman J Reuther is living in Greene Township. He is 39 years old, a day laborer, and was born in Germany. Herman immigrated in 1870, has been living in the US 30 years, and is a naturalized citizen. Living with him are his wife Sophia G, 34, born in Pennsylvania, and their children Jesse D, 11, and Della M, 9. Herman and Sophia have been married 17 years. She has had 4 children, 2 are living.

In the 1910 Census, Herman J Reuther is living in Greene Township. He is 49 years old, a farmer, and was born in Germany. He lists his year of immigration as 1870, and he is a naturalized citizen. Living with Herman are his wife Sophia, 44, and their children Jesse, 21, and Della M, 18. Jesse is a laborer doing odd farm jobs. Herman and Sophia have been married 27 years. She has given birth to four children, and two are living.

In the 1920 Census (Feb 1-2), Herman J Reuther is living in Greene Township. He is 59 years old, retired farmer, and was born in Bavaria. He immigrated in 1870 and is not a citizen. Living with him his wife Sophie G, 50?, and son Jesse D, 33.

Herman J Reuther died February 22, 1920. His wife Sophia was the administrator for his estate. [2]

Herman W Reuther died at his home in one and a half miles east of Carrol of pneumonia. He was engaged in lumbering and operated a cider mill. Herman was born in Bavaria in 1860. He was survived by his wife, daughter Mrs E W Lamey of Loganton, and son Jesse, who lives at home. [4]

Herman John Reuther's cause of death was recorded as tuberculosis. He has been suffering from T.B. for "several years". [5]

Herman married **Sophia Gertrude Zimmerman**,¹⁰ daughter of **David Zimmerman** and **Mary Ann Wren**, about 1883.¹¹ Sophia was born on 18 Sep 1865 in Lewis Township, Union County, Pennsylvania,¹² died on 3 Nov 1945 in Jersey Shore, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania¹³ at age 80, and was buried in Brungard's Cemetery, Greene Twp, Clinton County, Pennsylvania.¹² They had four children: **Irena, Jacob, Jesse David, and Della Gertrude**.

General Notes: Sophia Zimmerman was born at Tea Springs Lodge in Sugar Valley and lived there all her life. Her parents were among the first settlers of Tea Springs Lodge. [2]

Sophia's brother Jacob married Matilda Amm, Sophia's husband's 1st cousin once removed.

In the 1930 Census, Sophia G Reuther is living in Greene township, Clinton Co, Pennsylvania, with her son Jesse. She is 64 years old and a widow.

Sophia died in 3 November 1945 at the Jersey Shore Hospital. She was admitted a few days previously in a serious condition. Sophia was 80. [1, 2]

3-**Jesse David Reuther**¹⁵ was born on 21 Mar 1889 in Clinton County, Pennsylvania,¹⁶ died on 24 Jan 1950 in Jersey Shore, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania¹⁷ at age 60, and was buried in Fairview Cemetery, Loganton, Clinton County, Pennsylvania.¹⁸ He had no known marriage and no known children.

General Notes: Several birth dates were reported for Jesse. I have chosen 1889 as it is the most consistent with the censuses.

In the 1910 Census, Jesse is living with his parents and sister in Green Township, Clinton County, Pennsylvania. He is 21 years old and a laborer doing odd farm jobs. He was out of work 8 weeks in 1909.

In 1917 Jesse David Reuther is living in Clinton County (Loganton RFD). He is farming for his [father] Herman J Reuther in Carroll. Jesse is single, supporting his

parents, born 21 March 1889 in Greene township, and has poor eyes. [5]

In the 1920 Census, Jesse D Reuther is 33 years old and living with his parents in Greene township, Clinton County.

In the 1930 Census, Jesse D Reuther is living in Greene township. He is 41 years old and a farmer. Living with his is his mother Sophia.

In 1942 Jesse David Reuther is living in Greene township in Clinton County. He is working for the Department of Highways in Loganton. Jesse's sister Mrs Ellis Lamey is listed as his closest contact. Jesse was born 21 March 1889 in Clinton County. [3]

Jesse never married. [4]

Jesse D Reuther, of Loganton RD, died January 24, 1950, at Jersey Shore Hospital, where he was admitted on January 21. Jesse had been employed by the State Highway Department. [2]

Jesse died in January 1950 (estate file started Jan 30 1950). His sister Della M Lamey was the administrator for his estate. [1]

3-**Della Gertrude Reuther**¹² was born on 24 Oct 1891 in Greene Township, Clinton County, Pennsylvania,¹² died on 16 May 1975 in Pennsylvania²⁰ at age 83, and was buried in Fairview Evangelical Cemetery, Loganton, Clinton County, Pennsylvania.¹² Another name for Della was Della M Reuther.¹¹

General Notes: The Social Security Death Index had Della Lamey born 14 Oct 1891 died May 1975, last residence Loganton, Clinton Co, PA.

Fairview Evangelical Cemetery, Loganton, Clinton County, Pennsylvania.¹² Another name for Ellis was Ellis W Lamey.¹⁹ They had five children: **Howard Woodrow, Violet Louise, Josephine Ann, Glenn Calvin, and George Forbes.**

General Notes: In the 1920 Census, Ellis W Lamey is living in Loganton borough, Greene township, Clinton Co, Pennsylvania. He is 28 years old and a blacksmith with his own shop. Living with him are his wife Ella E, 27, children Howard W, 6, and Violet L, 2 years and 4 months, and his father John, 57.

In the 1930 Census, Ellis E Lamey is living in Loganton. He is 39, and a blacksmith with his own shop. Living with Ellis are his wife Della M, 38, and children Howard W, 17, Violet L, 12, Josephina A, 7, Glen C, 5, and George F, 9 months.

According to the Social Security Death Index, Ellis Lamey was born 22 Mar 1891 and died Jul 1964.

4-**Howard Woodrow Lamey**²⁶ was born on 1 Apr 1913 in Loganton, Clinton County, Pennsylvania,²⁷ died in Jan 1985²¹ at age 71, and was buried on 7 Jan 1985 in Jersey Shore Cemetery, Jersey Shore, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania.²⁸

General Notes: Howard married Edna Fenstermaker. Their children were Charles Dale Lamey & Virginia Lamey Heller. [1]

In 1940 Howard Woodrow Lamey registered for the WWII draft. He was living in Loganton and working for the W.P.A. His closest contact was father Ellis William Lamey. [3]

Howard Lamey was born 1 April 1913 and died January 1985. His last residence was Loganton, Clinton Co, Pennsylvania. [2]

Edna R. Lamey was born 8 March 1918 and died July 1995. Her last residence was in Loganton, Clinton, Pennsylvania. [1]

Charles Hughes reported Edna died in Lock Haven hospital in Jersey Shore. She probably died in either Lock Haven in Clinton County, or in Jersey Shore in Lycoming County.

He was also on the Jersey Shore School Board, the board of PA Tourist and was the Porter Township Supervisor. [1]

He enjoyed Florida, his motor home and boating. [1]

Glenn H. Hiller, of Jersey Shore, passed away 10 December 2007, possibly of Alzheimers. (The family requested contributions in his memory.) [1]
