1-Marie Sophie Speiser, ¹ daughter of Johannes Heinrich Speiser ¹ and Agnes Dorothea Holl ¹, was born on 21 Nov 1862 in Jesingen, Kingdom of Württemberg, ² died on 1 Jul 1940 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois ³ at age 77, and was buried on 3 Jul 1940 in Acacia Park Cemetery, Chicago, Illinois. ⁴ Another name for Marie was Marie Sofie Speiser. ⁵

General Notes: Marie and Gustav moved to Chicago. [1]

On 12 November 1910, Marie and her three children left Hamburg for New York on the ship Cleveland. They stopped in Southampton, England, and Cherbourg, France, arriving in New York on 23 November. Marie's most recent residence was Stuttgart. Daughter Gertrud, age 18, was listed on the passenger lists with her mother. Sons Hans, age 17, and Gustav, age 16, were on the same lists, but listed separately. Their final destination was Chicago. Various contacts in Germany were listed for them: Marie's sister Mrs Caroline Becker in Weilheim and son Gustav's uncle Geo Becker in Weilheim. Hans listed his contact as his father Gustav. [4, 5]

In 1920 Mary and Gustave Kolb are living in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, at 2142 Fremont Avenue. Gustav is a chemist with his own business. Living with them are three lodgers. Mary is 57, Gustav is 62. They were born in Germany, and immigrated in 1910. Gustav application to become a US citizen is pending. [2]

In 1930 Mary Kolb is living in Chicago at 2142 Fremont Avenue. She is 67, widowed, born in Germany, immigrated in 1910, and her citizenship application is pending. Mary owns her own home, worth \$6000, and has a radio. Six lodgers are living with her. [3]

In April 1940 Marie Kolb is living in Chicago with her son Hans and his family. Marie is 77, widowed, has a 4th grade education, and was born in Germany. She is listed on the Census as unable to work. [7]

Marie Kolb, born 21 November 1862 & wife of Gustav, died 1 July 1940 in Chicago. She was buried in Acacia Park Cemetery in Norridge, Illinois. [6]

Marie married **Gustav Kolb**, ⁶ son of **Karl Christian Ludwig "Louis" Kolb** and **Angelina Wilhelmina Laih**, on 3 Mar 1891 in Stuttgart, Kingdom of Württemberg. ⁷ Gustav was born on 25 Jul 1857 in Maulbronn, Kingdom of Württemberg, ⁸ died on 10 Oct 1924 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois ⁹ at age 67, and was buried on 13 Oct 1924 in Acacia Park Cemetery, Chicago, Illinois. ⁴ Another name for Gustav was Gustav Christoph Georg Franz Kolb. ⁷ They had three children: **Gertrud Angelika Dorothea, Hans Frederick**, and **Gustav**.

Marriage Notes: Marie married in München (Munich).

Gustav Christoph Georg Franz Kolb, born 25 July 1859, son of Louis Kolb & Angeline Wilhelmine Bach, married Marie Sophie Speiser, born 21 November 1862, daughter of Johann

Heinrich Speiser and Agnes Dorothea Holl, on 3 March 1891. [1]

General Notes: On the family record, Christoph Georg Franz Gustav Kolb's father was Carl Christian Ludwig Kolb, and on Gustav's marriage record his father was called Louis Kolb. [5]

Gustav's mother was incorrectly listed on the family register as Angelina Wilhelm Bach. Her name should be Laich or Laih, which corresponts to Gustav's death certificate. [5, 6, 4]

In 1891 when Gustav and Maria married, he was a miller in Maulbronn, as was his father. They lived in Maulbronn after their marriage. [5]

Gustav Kolb left Hamburg on 30 June 1910 on the ship Cincinnati headed for New York, stopping in Southampton, England, and Cherbourg, France. Gustav was 52, married, and a merchant. His most recent residence was in Stuttgart. His closest contact was his wife Marie Kolb in Stuttgart. Gustav arrived in New York on 11 July 1910, headed for Chicago. On the passenger list Gustav appears to have been marked as a Non Immigrant Alien. If this is correct, then he was already living in the US before this trip. [1, 2]

In 1920 Gustav is in Chicago and is a chemist with his own business. [7]

Gustav Kolb, retired watchman, son of Louie Kolb and Angelica Laih and husband of Marie, died on 10 October 1924 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. [3, 4]

2-**Gertrud Angelika Dorothea Kolb**¹⁰ was born on 15 Feb 1892 in Maulbronn, Kingdom of Württemberg, ¹⁰ was christened on 17 Apr 1892 in Maulbronn, Kingdom of Württemberg, died on 18 Jun 1958 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. ¹¹ at age 66, and was buried on 21 Jun 1958 in Acacia Park Cemetery, Chicago, Illinois. ¹²

General Notes: Gertrud immigrated to the US in 1910, arriving in New York from Hamburg on the ship Cleveland with her mother and brothers. She was 18 and a barmaid. [1]

In 1920 Gertrude and Joseph Wagner are living in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. Joseph is 29, born in Germany, and a cook at a hotel. Gertrude is 27, born in Germany, and a proprietor of a candy store. They immigrated in 1907 (should be 1910 for Gertrude), and Joseph's citizenship is pending. With them is their daughter Ruth, age 2 years and 6 months. [3]

In 1930 Gretchen (should be Gertrude) and Joseph Wagner are living in Chicago. They own their own home worth \$7500 and have a radio. They were first married at age 26 and 27 (about 1916). Joseph is the manager of his own restaurant. With them are their children

Ruth, 12, and Richard, 6. [4]

In 1940 Gertrude Wagner is living in Chicago with husband Joseph, and children Ruth, 22, and son Richard, 16. Gertrude has an 8th grade education. [5]

Gertrude Wagner was listed as surviving her brother Hans when he died in 1957. [2]

Gertrude Wagner died 18 Jun 1958 in Chicago. She was born 15 February 1892 in Germany to Gustav Kolb. The informant was Germaine Mouran. Burial 21 June in Acacia Park. [6]

Gertrud married **Joseph Wagner**, ¹³ son of **Baltazar Wagner** and **Wilhelmina Strauss**, about 1916. ¹⁴ Joseph was born on 28 Apr 1890 in Eubigheim, Grand Duchy of Baden, ¹⁵ died on 26 Oct 1957 in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois ¹⁶ at age 67, and was buried on 29 Oct 1957 in Acacia Park Cemetery, Chicago, Illinois. ¹⁷ They had two children: **Ruth Virginia** and **Richard K**.

General Notes: Joseph Wagner immigrated in 1907. [2, 6]

In 1910 Joseph Wagner is living in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. He is 20 years old, born in Germany, and is a cook at a hotel. Joseph is living in the home of Pence C & Elizabeth Miclos along with six other boarders. [6]

In 1918, Joseph Wagner was living in Chicago. He was single, a cook at the Bismark Hotel, and suffered from bad eye sight. Joseph was born 28 April 1890 in Eubigheim [Baden], Germany, and has delcared his intention to become a citizen. [1]

In 1940 Joseph Wagner owns a house at 1836 Greenleaf Ave in Chicago. The house is worth \$3500. It looks like Joseph is renting out part of the house. Joseph has an 8th grade education, his naturalization is pending, and he owns a restaurant. [4]

In 1942 Joseph Wagner is living in Chicago at 1836 Greenleaf Ave. He is employed at Union Restaurant at 671 N. Madison St where he is part owner. Joseph's closest contact is [daughter] Miss Ruth Wagner at the same home address. Joseph was born 28 April 1890 in Baden, Germany. [3]

Joseph Adam Wagner died 26 Oct 1957 at his home on Greenleaf Ave in Chicago of a coronary occlusion. Joseph was a chef at a restaurant. His death certificate reported he had been in Chicago for 43 years [since about 1914] and in his present home for 34 years [since about 1923]. [5]

Other records (1942 draft) specifically show Joseph's middle name as none.

General Notes: In 1940 Ruth Wagner is living in Chicago with her parents and younger brother. Ruth is 22, and has completed high school. She is not employed. [2]

General Notes: Note: The Richard K Wagner who died 2 June 2011 and was married to Verna Sward, is confirmed as "our" Richard Wagner based on a tree on Ancestry that combines the families of Gertrude Kolb & Joseph Wagner with the Sward family. [1]

In 1942 Richard Wagner registered for the WWII draft in Chicago. He was born 25 May 1923 in Chicago. He is unemployed. His closest contact is sister Ruth Wagner, at the same address. [4]

Richard, his sister Ruth, and Richard's wife and children lived in Chicago at 1836 W Greenleaf Ave, the same home as Richard's parents. [3]

Richard K. Wagner, 88, of Chicago, passed away June 2, 2011. Beloved husband of Verna E., nee Sward; loving father of Frederick (Lynn), Clifford (Phyllis), Susan (Joe) Hartnett and Kenneth; cherished grandfather of Edmund, Elizabeth and Jenna Hartnett, Emily, Natalie, Ilyse, Jacob and Susan Wagner and Jeremy Williams; dear brother of the late Ruth Wagner. age 95. They had four children: Frederick, Clifford, Susan, and Kenneth.

General Notes: From a tree on Ancestry.com, Verna's parents are Jacob Sward and Wilma Helenius. [1] Other research confirms.

Verna's parents immigrated from Finland. Father Jacob in 1900, and Wilma Helenius, age 18, appeared to be traveling alone, from Liverpool to Quebec to the United States in July 1914. [2, 3]

In 1920 Vieno Sward is 9 months old and living with her family in Oma, Iron County, Wisconsin. Parents Jacob J Sward, Wilma, and sister Ilona, age 2 yr/2 mo. Both girls were born in Michigan. Jacob and Wilma born in Finland. Jacob is a farmer. [5]

In 1930 Veins Sward is 10 years old and living in Oma with her family. Parents Jacob J Sward, Wilma E Sward, siblings Gladys M, 12, Carlo J, 8, and Anna W, 7. The younger children were born in Wisconsin. [6]

In 1935, when Verna was 16, she was living in Deerfield, Lake County, Illinois. [4]

In 1940 Verna Sward is living in Higland Park, Lake County, Illinois. She is 21, born in Michigan, single, working as a maid for the family of Alfred Turner, and has an 8th grade education. [4]

Verna E Wagner, nee Sward, died February 2015.

2-Hans Frederick Kolb²⁸ was born on 21 Mar 1893 in Maulbronn, Kingdom of Württemberg,²⁹ was christened on 11 May 1893 in Maulbronn, Kingdom of Württemberg,³⁰ died on 15 Jan 1957 in Illinois³¹ at age 63, and was buried on 18 Jan 1957 in Acacia Park Cemetery, Chicago, Illinois.³² Another name for Hans was Hans Friedrich Kolb.³⁰

General Notes: Hans immigrated to the US in 1910, arriving in New York from Hamburg on the ship Cleveland with his mother, sister and brother. He was 17 and a cook. [1]

In 1917 Hans Kolb was living in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, perhaps on East 50th Street. He is single and a chauffer for N A Humphries. Hans has declared his intention to become a citizen. [2]

In 1930 Hans F Kolp (should be Kolb) is living in Chicago, on Bennett Avenue. He is 37, born in Wuerttemberg, and the owner of an auto repair shop. Hans immigrated in 1910 and is a naturalized citizen. With Hans are his wife Ellen, 22, born in Indiana, and sons William, 5, and Robert 1 year, 8 months. Hans and Ellen were married at age 30 and 16. [4]

In 1940 Hans Kolb is living in Chicago at 1721 E 86th Street. He is 47, born in Germany, has an 8th grade education, and is the proprietor of an auto repair shop. With Hans are wife Ellen, 32, sons William, 15, and Robert, 11, and mother Marie Kolb. [6]

In 1942 Hans Fredick Kolb is living at 1721 E 86th St in Chicago. He is self-employed at 5600 Lake Park ave. Hans was born 21 March 1893 in Wurthberg [Wuerttemberg], Germany. His closest contact is [wife] Ellen Waters Kolb. [5]

Hans F Kolb of Spring Grove (McHenry County), Illinois, died in January 1957. He was survived by his wife Ellen, sons William F & Robert H, grandson Lawrence W, brother Gustaf Kolb, and sister Gertrude Wagner. He was buried in Acacia Park Cemetery in Chicago. [3]

Hans married **Ellen Ione Waters**,³⁵ daughter of **Jesse J Waters** and **Lydia Bell Tebo**, on 29 Dec 1923 in Cook County, Illinois.³⁶ Ellen was born in 1907 in South Bend, Indiana,³⁷ died on 25 Feb 1962 in Illinois.³⁸ at age 55, and was buried in Acacia Park

Cemetery, Chicago, Illinois.²¹ Another name for Ellen was Ellen T Waters.³⁹ They had two children: **William Fredrick** and **Robert Howard**.

General Notes: Research with the census, marriage records, and Ancestry tree shows Ellen's mother was Lydia (or Lyda) Belle Tebo. [4]

Belle Tebo married her first husband Frank L Williams in 1882 in Buchanan, Berrien County, Michigan. Both were residents of South Bend, Indiana. [5] Frank Williams died in South Bend in 1898. [6]

Lydia Belle Williams married Jesse Waters in 1899. [7]

In 1900 Jesse J Waters, wife Belle L Waters, are living in South Bend, Indiana. With them are four Williams children from Belle's first marriage, and six boarders. [11]

In 1910 Ellen T Waters is 3 years old and in South Bend, Indiana, with her parents Jesse J Waters, Belle L Waters, brother Myrell Waters, age 5, and [half] sister Rhoda Williams (age 16 and a jeweler at a watch factory). Jesse immigrated from England in 1880, and is a plasterer. [10]

Ellen's mother Belle died in 1914. [4]

Ellen had a 8th grade education. [1]

In 1920 Ellen Waters is living in Chicago, Illinois, with her older half-sister Louetta and Louetta's husband Hosey Keller. Also in the house is a lodger William Stutsman. Ellen is 12 and born in Indiana. Hosey is a waiter and Louetta is a hairdresser. [3]

Ellen's full brother is probably the Merl Waters, age 15, lodging in South Bend in 1920 with the Clark family. [10]

Ellen's father Jesse Waters died in South Bend, Indiana, on 23 January 1920. Just before his death he was lodging with Robert Morgan and his family in South Bend. Jesse was 57 and a plasterer. [6, 8]

Ellen W Kolb, age 54, of Spring Grove, Illinois, died on 25 February 1962. She was the wife of the late Hans, and mother of William F Kolb of Oak Lawn, and Robert H Kolb of Spring Grove. She had one grandson. [2]

2-**Gustav Kolb**³⁰ was born on 20 Apr 1894 in Maulbronn, Kingdom of Württemberg,²⁹ was christened on 10 Jun 1894 in Maulbronn, Kingdom of Württemberg,³⁰ died on 7 Sep 1976 in Cook County, Illinois⁴³ at age 82, and was buried in Acacia Park Cemetery, Chicago, Illinois.²¹

General Notes: Gustav immigrated to the US in 1910, arriving in New York from Hamburg on the ship Cleveland with his mother, sister and brother. He was 16 and a waiter. [1]

In 1917 Gustave Kolb was living in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, with his parents at their home at 2142 Fremont St. Gustav was born 20 April 1894 in Maulbronn, Wuerttemberg, Germany. He is single, and a doorman at Chicago Athletics on Michigan Avenue. Gustav has declared his intention to become a citizen. He had 3 years of service as a private in the calvary for Illinois. [2]

In 1920 Gustav is living in Chicago. He is 26. On 12 January Gustav is renting rooms from Appoluia Laudgraf and is working as a laborer in a factory. By 21 January, Gustav has taken a position as a caretaker for a private family and is living on Lake Shore Drive at the home of Jack and Mary Peabody. With Gustav are his wife Clara, 28, and daughter Eleanor. Eleanor is 10 or 11 months old. [3]

Gustav Kolb was born 20 April 1894 and died in September 1976. His last residence was in Chicago. [6]
